We're pleased to present to you this year's Annual Water Quality Report. This report is designed to inform you of the quality of the water and services we deliver to you every day. Our constant goal is to provide you with a safe, dependable supply of drinking water. We want you to understand the efforts we are making to continually improve the treatment process and protect our water resources. We are committed to ensuring the quality of your water. Our source consists of three wells that draw from the Maud and the Tusculooza Aquifers.

A source water assessment has been completed for the water supply to determine the overall susceptibility of drinking water to identify potential sources of contamination. The water supply for the Town of Scooba received a low susceptibility ranking to contamination.

We're pleased to report that our drinking water meets all federal and state requirements. If you have any questions about this report or concerning your water utility, please contact C. Holliday at 476-8451. We want our valued customers to be informed about their water utility and want to learn more please attend a special meeting being held on Monday, July 7, 2014 at Town Hall at 888 Kemper St. at 7:00 p.m.

The Town of Scooba routinely monitors for constituents in your drinking water according to and State laws. This table shows the results of our monitoring for the period of January 1st to December 31st, 2013. As water travels over the land or underground, it can pick up substances or elements such as microbes, inorganic and organic chemicals, and radioactive substances. All water, including bottled drinking water, may be reasonably expected to contain at least some of these substances. It's important to remember that the presence of these substances does not necessarily pose a health risk.

In this table you will find many terms and abbreviations you might not be familiar with. To better understand these terms we've provided the following definitions:

Action Level - the concentration of a contaminant which, if exceeded, triggers treatment or requirements which a water system must follow.

Treatment Technique (TT) - A treatment technique is a required process intended to reduce or eliminate a contaminant in drinking water.

Maximum Contaminant Level - The "Maximum Allowed" (MCL) is the highest level of a maximum that is allowed in drinking water. MCLs are set as close to the MCLGs as feasible using available treatment technology.

Maximum Contaminant Level Goal - The "Goal" (MCLG) is the level of a contaminant in water below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MCLGs allow for margin of

Additional Information for Lead

If present, elevated levels of lead can cause serious health problem, especially for pregnant and young children. Lead in drinking water is primarily from materials and components with service lines and home plumbing. The Town of Scooba is responsible for providing drinking water, but cannot control the variety of materials used in plumbing components. Water has been sitting for several hours, you can minimize the potential for lead exposure if you tap for 30 seconds to 2 minutes before using water for drinking or cooking. If you are about lead in your water, you may wish to have your water tested. Information on lead water testing methods, and steps you can take to minimize exposure is available from the Drinking Water Hotline or at http://www.epa.gov/safewater/lead. The Mississippi State Dept. Health Public Health Laboratory offers lead testing for \$10 per sample. Please contact 601-378-1000 if you wish to have our water tested.
