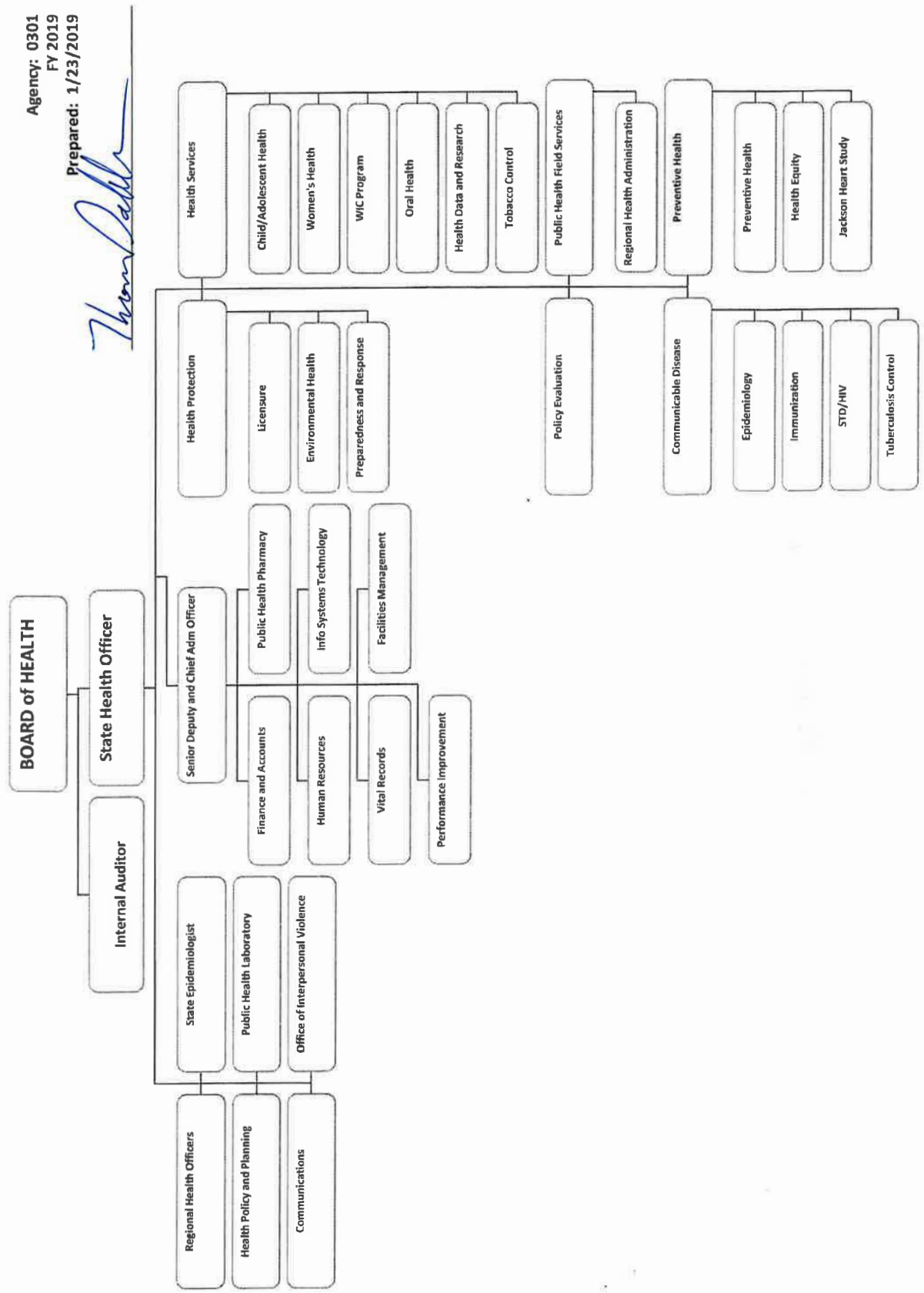

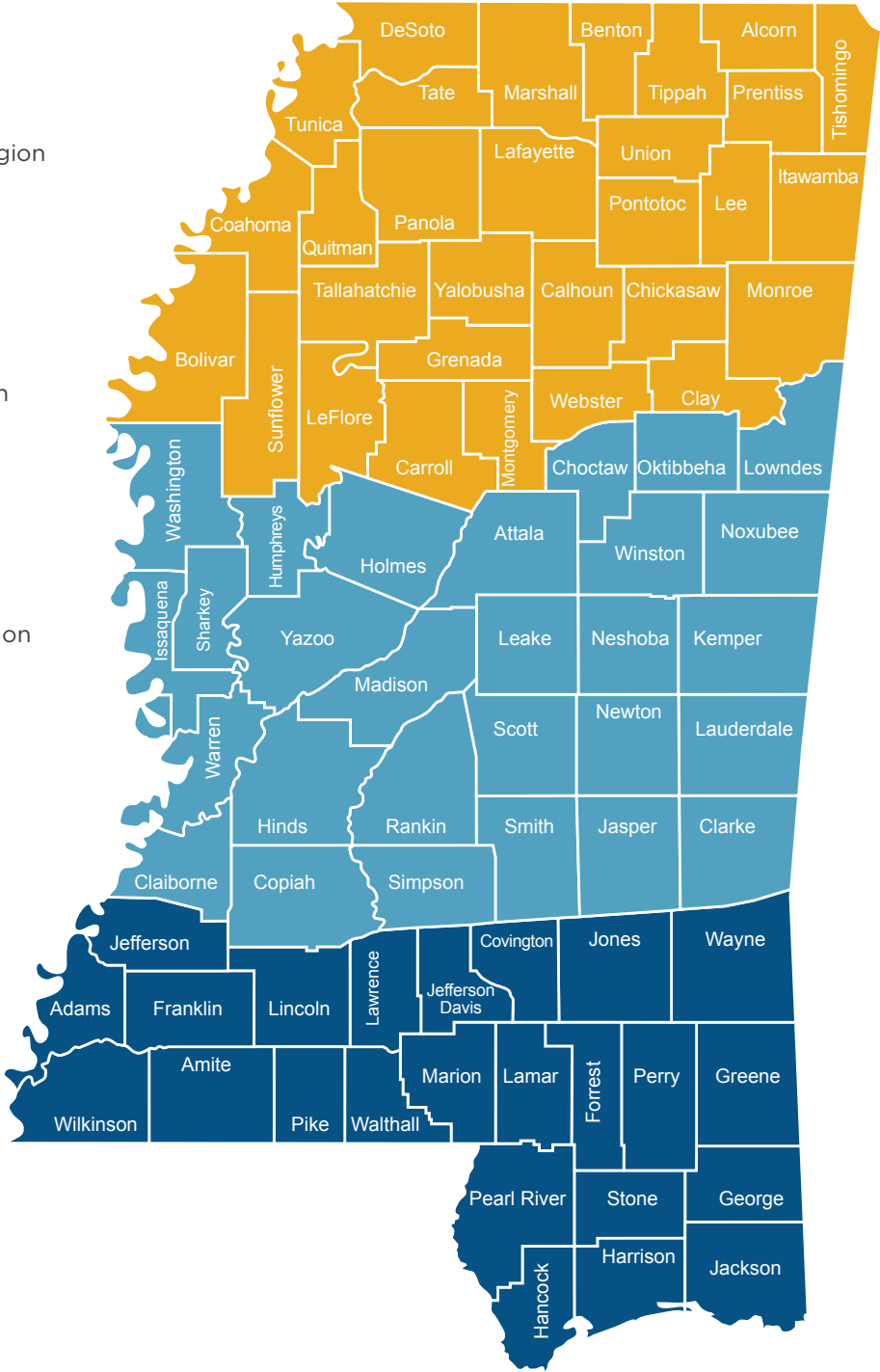

CHANGES IN REGULATIONS FISCAL YEAR 2019

The following final regulatory actions were taken by the Mississippi State Board of Health in FY 2019:

JULY 2018

[Final Adoption of Amendments to the Emergency Medical Services Regulations](#)

Amended the regulations to delete the sections on Emergency Medical Technician-Intermediate and add the sections on Emergency Medical Technician-Advanced; and changed references from “EMT Intermediate” to “Advanced EMT.”

[Final Adoption of Modifications to the Mississippi On-Site Wastewater Disposal System Rules and Regulations](#)

Amended the regulations to allow for Certified Installers, Pumpers, and Manufacturers to receive a three-year license and established fees for a three-year license.

[Final Adoption of Modifications to the Mississippi Regulations for Control of Radiation](#)

Amended the regulations to comply with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Regulations.

OCTOBER 2018

[Final Adoption of Amendment to the Mississippi Trauma Care System Regulations](#)

Amended the regulations to combine all performance improvement rules for trauma centers, burn centers and pediatric centers in Chapter 2 of the regulations.

[Final Adoption of Amendments to the Regulations Governing Drinking Water Quality Analysis Fund](#)

Amended the regulations to allow the Board of Health to adopt a fee schedule for water quality analysis fees and related activities.

[Final Adoption of Modifications to the Mississippi Stroke System of Care Plan](#)

Modified the plan to clarify the use of the Stroke EMS Triage and Destination Guideline and Mississippi EMS Stroke Model Treatment Protocol; add a new AHA/ASA criteria; require that a stroke team include a neurologist instead of a neurosurgeon; require that a Level II Stroke Center have a transfer plan in place for patients to a higher level of care if needed for endovascular or surgical treatments; require that transition plans for the transfer of patients who do not respond to “IV Alteplase or outside IV Alteplase window” be in place at Level III Stroke Centers; and clarify the process for designation of Stroke Centers.

CHANGES IN REGULATIONS FISCAL YEAR 2019

APRIL 2019

Final Adoption of Amendments to the Emergency Medical Services Regulations

Amended the regulations to add additional level of personnel licensure, required reporting and implement updated certification process.

Final Adoption of Amendments to the Mississippi Trauma Care System Regulations

Amended Appendix B to the regulations to update trauma activation criteria.

Final Adoption of Amendments to the Minimum Standards of Operation of Pediatric Skilled Nursing Facilities

Amended the regulations to ensure for the transfer of patients over the age of 21, who are currently aging-in-place at a teaching hospital, to a pediatric skilled nursing facility provided certain criteria are met.

Approval of FY 2019 Trauma System of Care Plan

Amended the regulations to provide for transport of burn patients meeting specific criteria, who do not require initial stabilization at trauma centers, directly to burn centers and to reflect changes to the Trauma System of Care Rules and Regulations approved by the Board of Health

Approval of Bureau of Health Facilities Licensure and Certification Fee Schedule

Amended the regulations to increase the fees of licensed health care facilities by 15%

CHANGES IN STATE LAW

Legislative Update for the 2019 Mississippi Legislative Session

HOUSE BILL 626. Signed 03/21/2019. Effective 07/01/2019.

Amended the CON law to direct the Supreme Court to expedite judicial review of an appeal of the final order of the Chancery Court so that the Chancery Court renders a final order no later than 120 days from the date the appeal is received from the Department.

HOUSE BILL 1048. Signed 03/21/2019. Effective 07/01/2019.

Designates the Mississippi State Board of Health as the regulatory authority for hemodialysis technicians, a role previously assigned to the Board of Nursing.

HOUSE BILL 1160. Signed 03/19/2019. Effective 07/01/2019.

Allows bonds to be issued to build the Center for Medically Fragile Children, a Pediatric Skilled Nursing Facility, which is regulated by the Mississippi State Department of Health.

HOUSE BILL 1206. Signed 03/19/2019. Effective 07/01/2019.

Exempted vending machines and micro markets that sell prepackaged food and other food products from the regulatory authority of the Mississippi State Board of Health.

HOUSE BILL 1547. Signed 04/16/2019. Effective 07/01/2019.

Amended the following sections of the Mississippi Controlled Substances Act: 41-29-113, Mississippi Code of 1972, to revise Schedule I of the Controlled Substances Act to include Butyrl fentanyl, Fentanyl-related substances, and Schedule II to exclude Naldemedine and Schedule V of the Controlled Substances Act to add approved cannabidiol and established the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Task Force composed of 13 members, including the MSDH Director of Pharmacy or her designee.

SENATE BILL 2840. Signed 04/16/2019. Effective 07/01/2019.

Revises the provisions concerning the investigatory and reporting duties of the Child Death Review Panel to include child near fatalities and allows the Children's Safe Center to access and analyze data from MS-HIN to identify data necessary for the Review Panel's reporting.

SENATE BILL 3065. Signed 04/12/2019. Effective upon passage.

Increased from \$32,843,000.00 to \$33,843,000.00 the amount of state general obligation bonds authorized to be issued for the Local Government and Rural Water Systems Improvements Revolving Loan Fund.

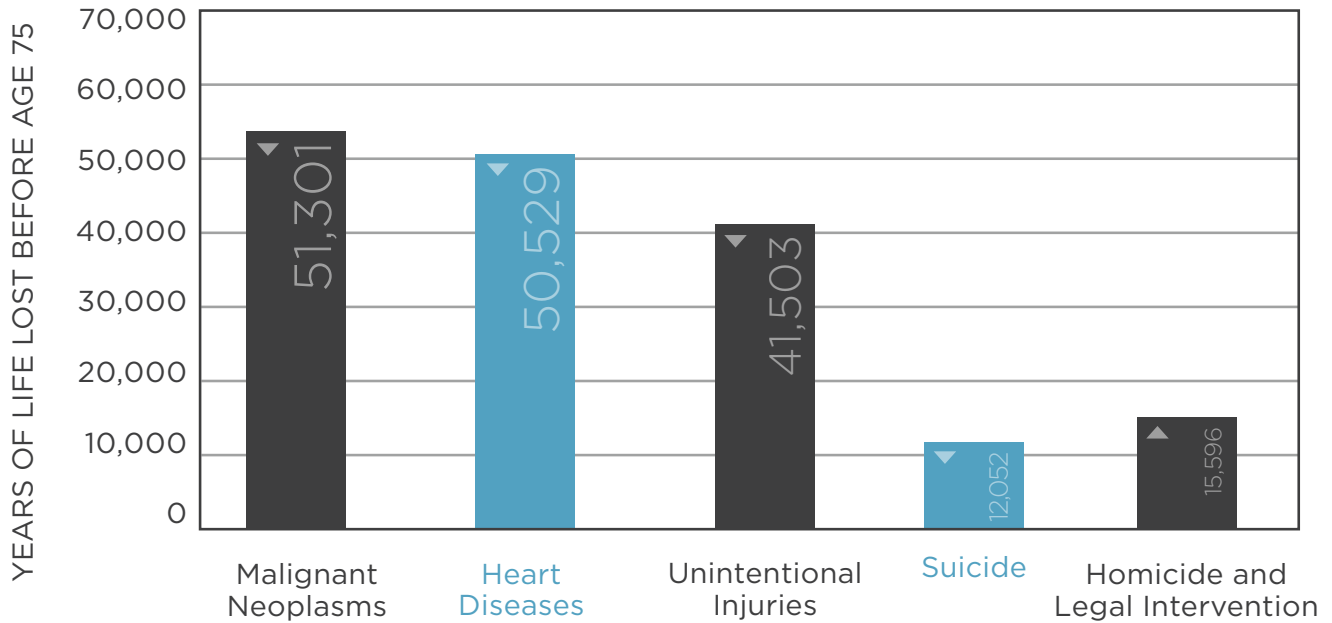

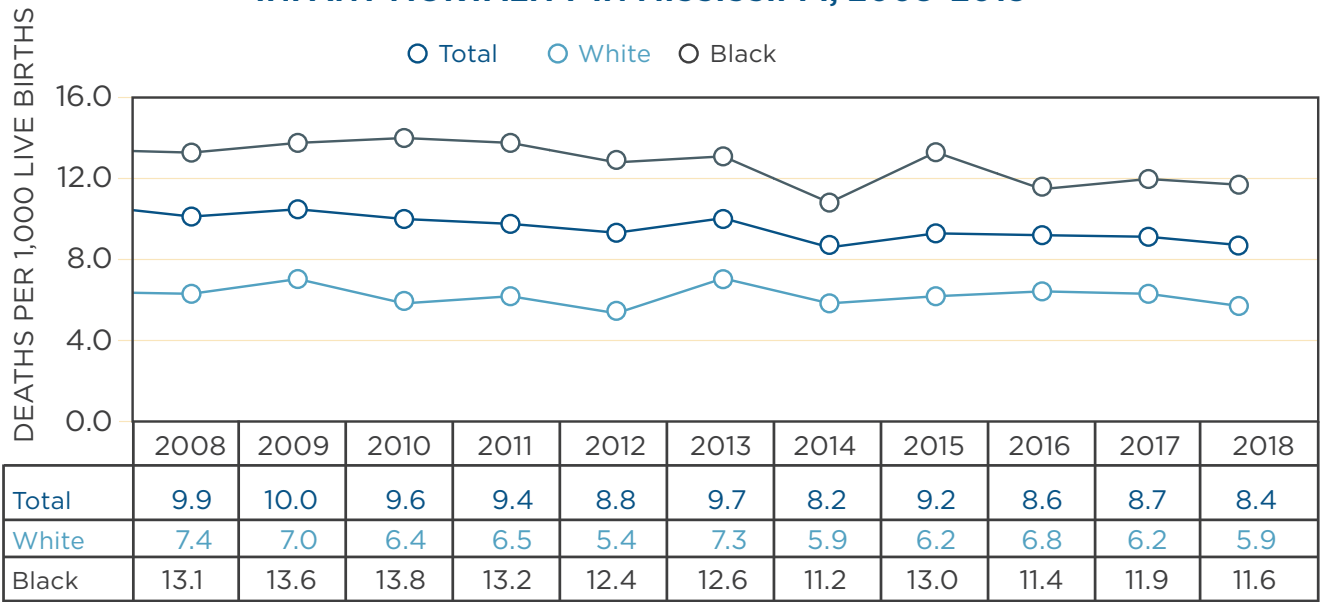

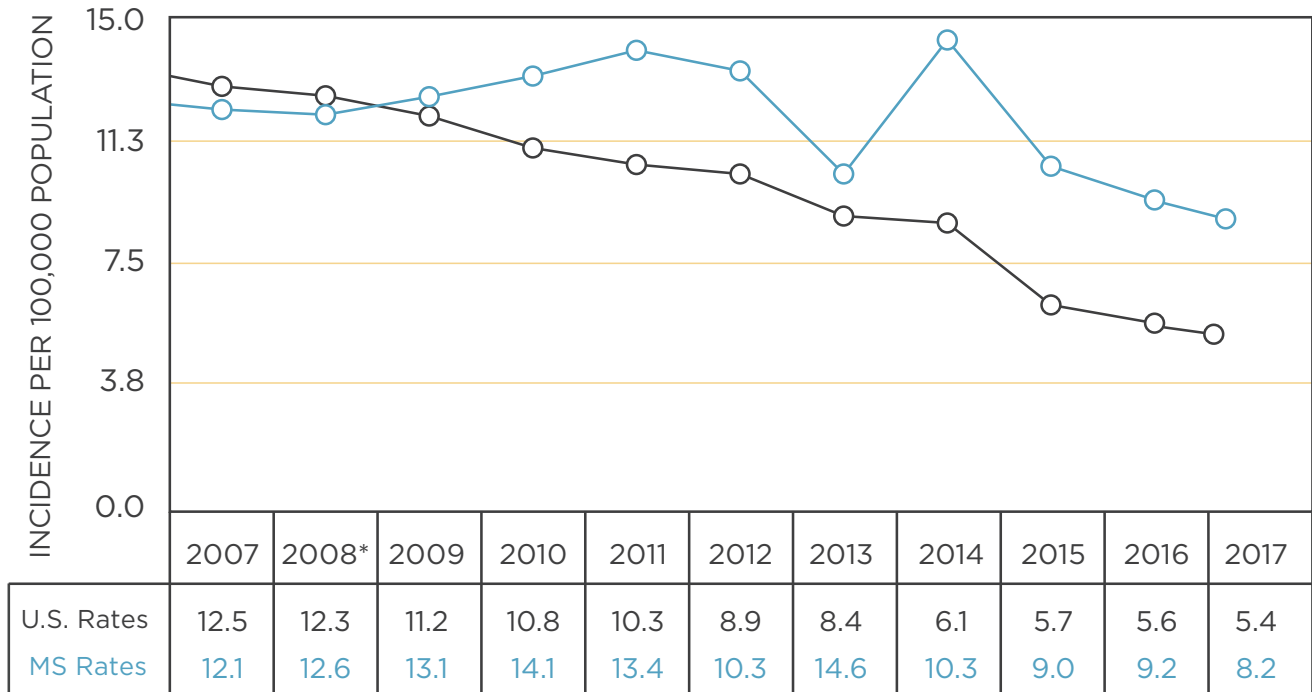
INFANT MORTALITY IN MISSISSIPPI, 2008-2018

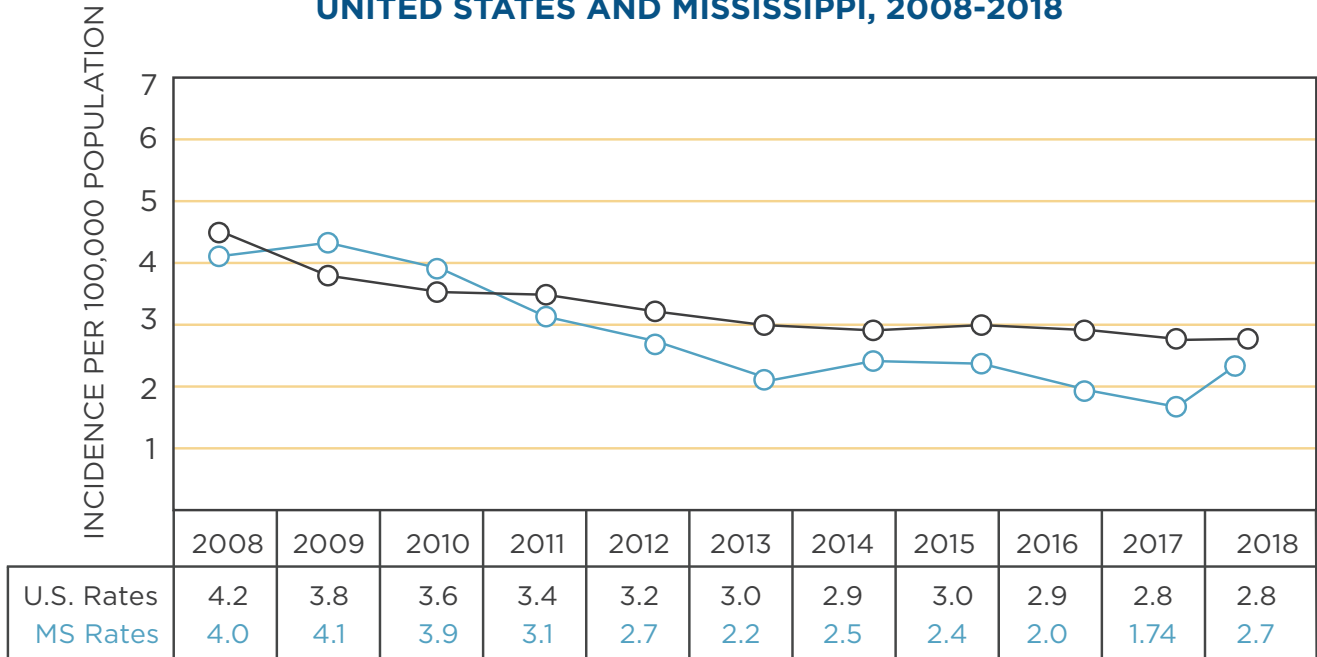

AIDS RATES BY YEAR, UNITED STATES AND MISSISSIPPI, 2007-2017

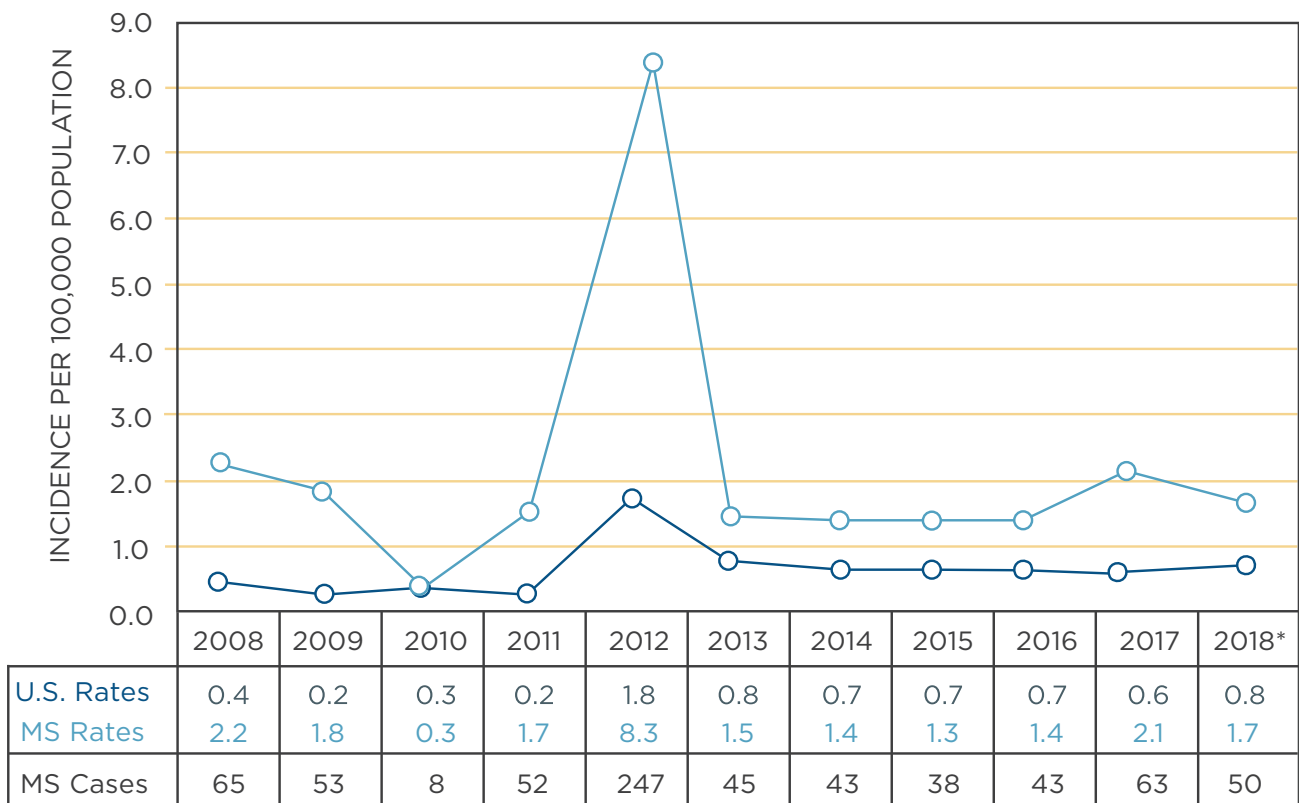

TUBERCULOSIS RATES BY YEAR, UNITED STATES AND MISSISSIPPI, 2008-2018

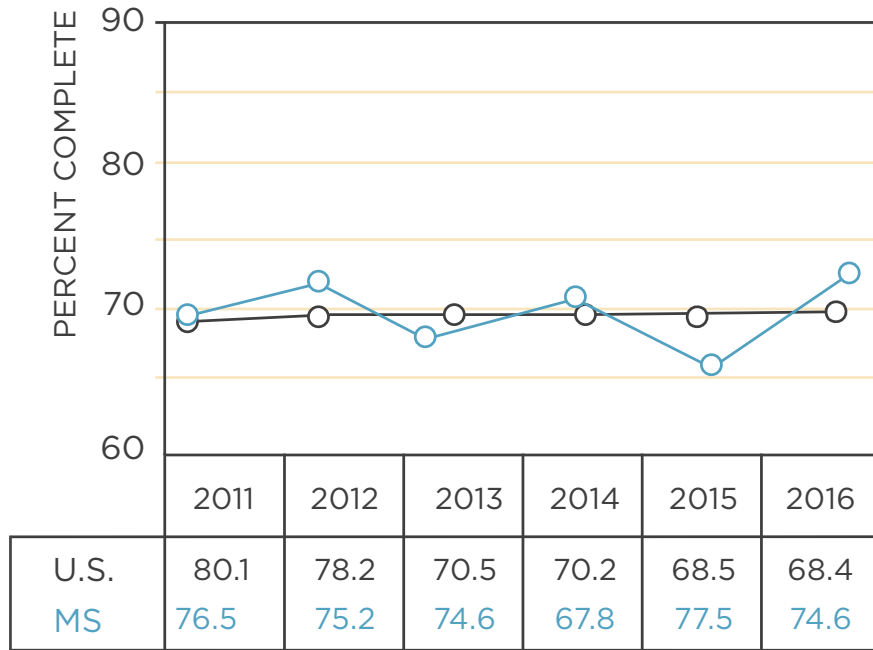


WEST NILE VIRUS RATES BY YEAR, UNITED STATES AND MISSISSIPPI, 2008-2018

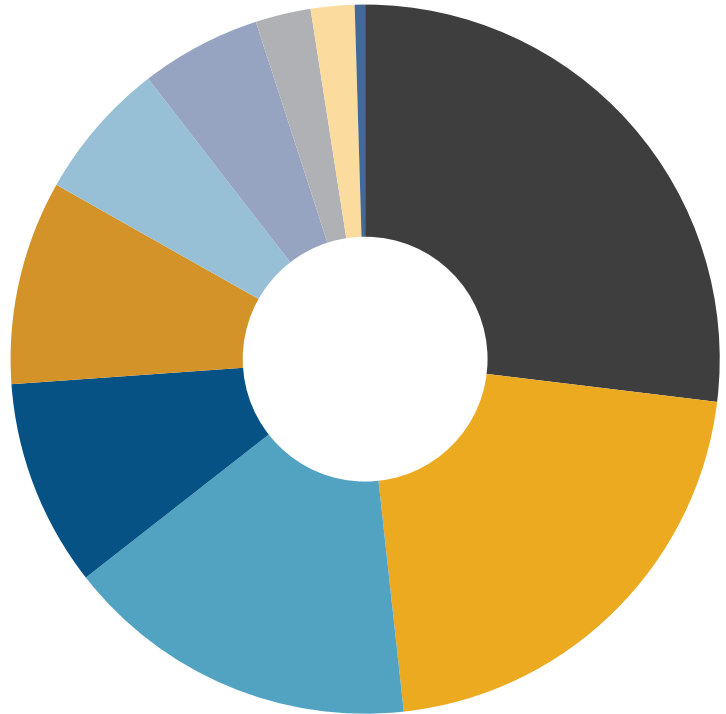

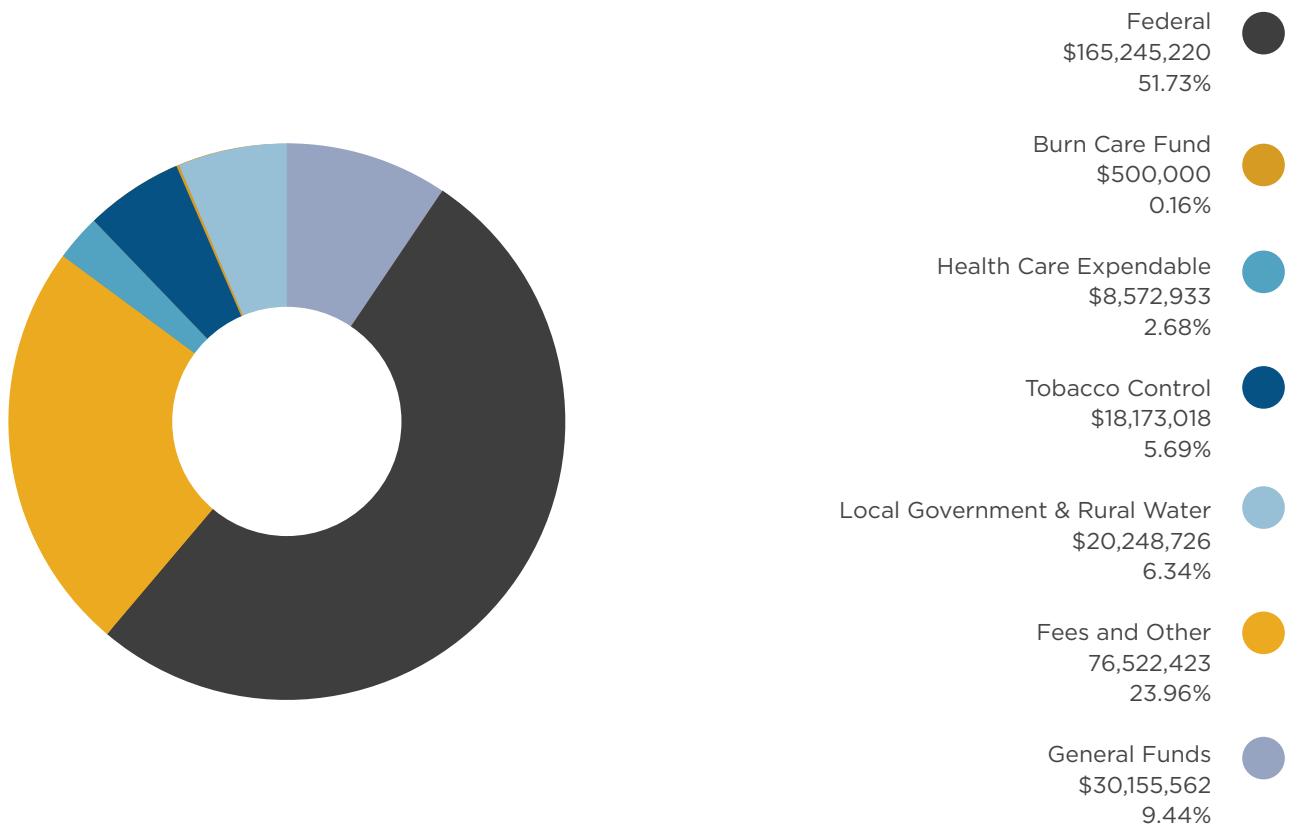

FISCAL YEAR 2019 EXPENDITURES BY EXPENDITURE CATEGORY



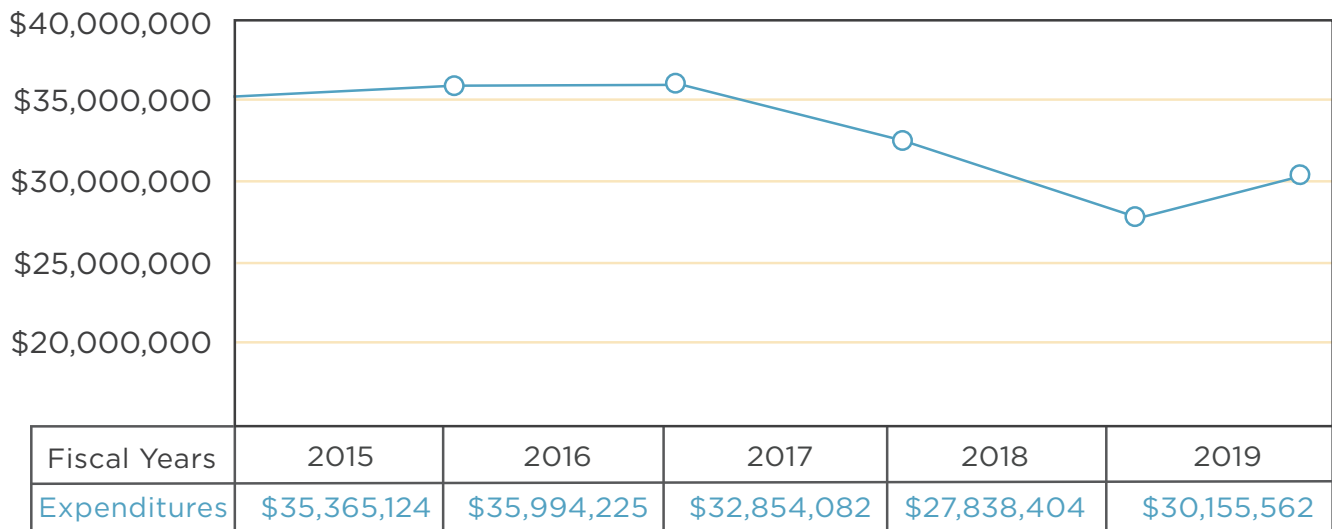

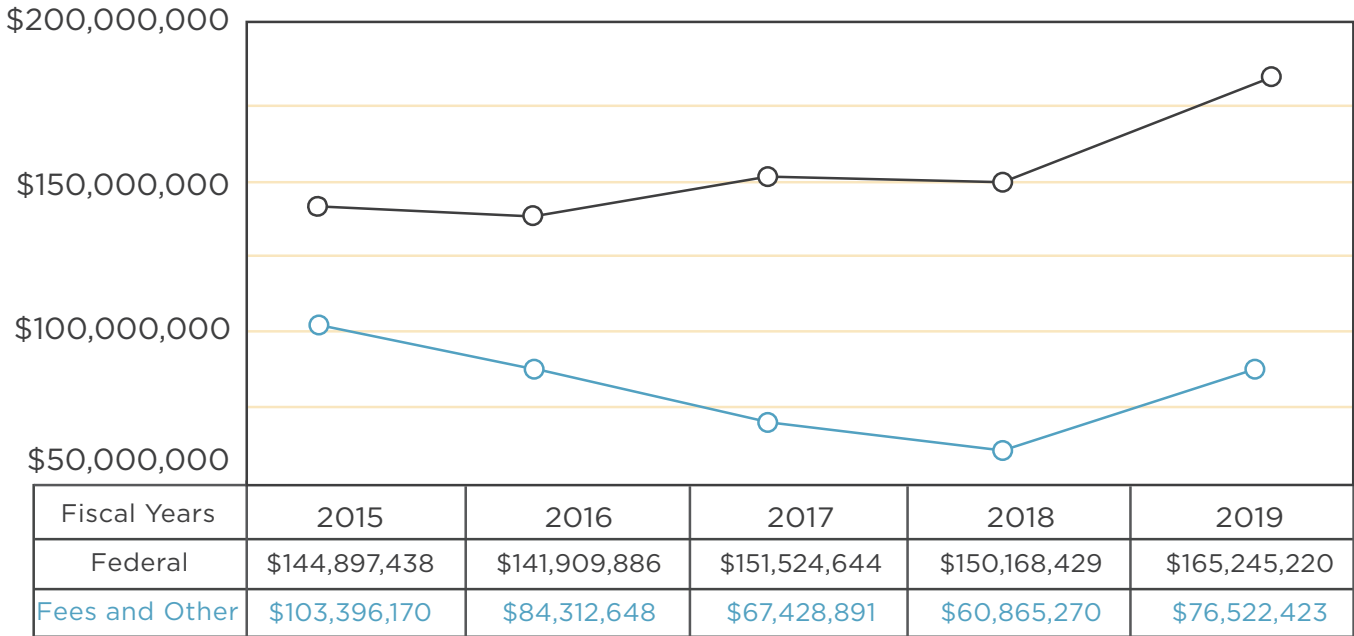
