Home Health Agencies

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Overvi ew

There were 69 home health agencies in 1998; 26 free-standing, 28 hospital-based, and 15 health department home health agencies. Hospital-based Kare-In Home Health changed to free-standing. Northwest Mississippi Regional Medical Center Home Health closed. Coastal Plains home Health Agency Region B is inactive. Van Winkle Home Health relocated from Copiah County to Hinds County.

Three agencies changed names; Jasper General Hospital Home Health Agency was rename Pro-Care Home Health, Parkview Home Health changed to River Region Home Care, and Tri-County Home Health of Mississippi is MHC of Central Mississippi.

Map I shows the location of home health agencies by type in 1998.

Table I shows that 55% of home health agencies reported non-profit status. Approximately 58% of the agencies were controlled by corporations, 21.7% were controlled by state government, 17.4% were controlled by local government and the remaining 1.5% were controlled by other.

Referrals by type of home health agency are shown in Table II. Of the 59,938 total referrals, 54,217 or 90.5% were accepted. Reasons for denied service are shown in Table II. Besides the category 'other', not meeting home health service eligibility was the main reason patients were denied service. Most referrals, 95.6% were from physicians and hospitals.

For this report, data from hospital-based home health agencies are shown in tables ending in an A, health department home health agencies are shown in tables ending in a B, free-standing home health agencies are shown in tables ending in a C, and tables ending in a D represent state totals.

Patients Served

There were 69,105 patients served during 1998. This is a non-duplicate count of people. Total number of patients served during 1997 was 82,143.

Table III shows type of services provided by home health agencies. Skilled nursing and home health aides are provided by all home health agencies. Fifty-five agencies provide physical therapy services, 57 agencies provided speech/audic services, 59 agencies provide social services, 44 agencies provide occupational therapy services, 22 agencies provide nutrition and 6 agencies provide respiratory therapy. Appliance/equipment data is no longer being captured.

Map II displays number of agencies serving each county. Counties in central, coastal and southeastern areas are served by more home health agencies. Included in the count are total number of agencies authorized to serve counties.

Table IV shows home health patients served by source of payment. The majority of patients, 71,756 or 82.3% were covered by Medicare, followed by 6,301 or 7.2% by Medicaid. The remaining 9,176 patients were covered by private insurance, self pay, charity or unaccounted for (2,210).

Chart I displays percent of home health agency patients served by type of agency.

Table V displays number of patients served by agency during calendar year 1998 by source of payment. Of hospital-based home health agencies, South Mississippi Home Health Region I served the most patients, 6,353, followed by North Mississippi Medical Center Home Health with 5,178 patients served. Southwest Home Health Agency Region C and Tombigbee Home Health Agency Region A served the most health departmentations, 313 and 312 respectively. Of free-standing agencies, Sta-Home Health Agency in Carthage served the most patients, 3,368.

Chart II displays number and percent of patients served, and Table VI provides number of patients served by agency by county. Table VII shows number of patients served by type of service. Skilled nursing services had the greatest number of patients, 77,533 followed by home health aides, 42,482.

Patients served during calendar year 1998 by type of services provided by county may be found in Table VIII. Hospital-based agencies served 44,078 patients, a decrease of 9,417 patients or -17.6% of change from 1997.

There was a decrease of 3728 health department patients served, or -12.8% of change from 1997. Reported health department home health patients totaled 2,546 in 1998 compared to 2,918 in 1997.

Free-standing home health agency patients decreased by 2,327 from 1997.

Chart III displays total home health agency patients served during calendar year 1998 by type of services provided.

Map III shows home health regions within public health districts. At the present time there are no agencies in Districts III or V.

Table IX shows home health patients served by Region. Region V served the most patients, 16,047 or 18.4%, followed by Region IX with 12,435 or 14.2%.

Home health patients served during calendar years 1985-1998 by type of service are shown in Table X. Patients served increased from 41,923 in 1985 to 54,448 in 1990 to 86,416 in 1998.

Vi si ts

Table XI displays home health agency visits by source of payment. The majority of visits, 4,860,219 or 92.3%, were paid by Medicare, followed by Medicaid which paid for 270,736 or 5.1%. Private insurance, self pay and charity made up the other 2.6%.

Chart IV shows percent of home health visits by method of payment. For example, of the total Medicare 4,860,219 visits, 54.1% or 2,629,813 were free-standing agency visits. Approximately 43% or 2,102,266 were hospital-based visits. Health department visits accounted for the remaining 128,140 visits.

Home health agency visits by agency during calendar year 1998 by source of payment may be found in Table XII. Of the hospital-based agencies, North Mississippi Medical Center reported the most visits, 360,454, followed by South Mississippi Home Health Region I with 279,667. Tombigbee Home Health Agency

Region B reported the most health department visits with 16,068. Sta-Home Health Agency Carthage reported the most free-standing visits with 280,841 followed by Mid Delta Home Health reported the most free-standing agency visits with 258,897. Home Health Agency visits by agency may be found in Table XIII.

Table XIV shows number of patient visits by type of service. County data is shown in Table XV. Home health aide visits accounted for more than half of the 5,265,550 visits. Skilled nursing comprised 39.5% and physical therapy 5%. Social services, speech/audio, occupational therapy, and respiratory therapy visits made up the other 114,924 visits.

Chart V shows percent of home health visits by type of service.

Table XVI shows home health visits by home health regions. Region V reported the most visits with 1,010,852, followed by Region III with 793,653, and Region IX with 706,944.

Total home health agency visits during calendar years 1985-1998 are shown in Table XVII. Home health agency visits increased from 1,418,855 in 1985 to 3,024,143 in 1990 to 5,265,458 visits in 1998.

Home health agency admissions by agency by county are reported in Table XVIII.

Total home health agency patient census decreased by 9,418 patients. Table XIX shows that the beginning census was 30,588 and ending census was 21,170.

Employee data are shown in Table XX. Nurses and aides constitute the largest group of employees, 4,265 or 71.3% of the total. Home health employees decreased from 8,632 in 1997 to 5,979 in 1998.

An alphabetical listing of home health agencies can be found in Appendix A.

There is a list of home health agencies by classification by county in Appendix B. Counties served by each agency are indicated. A copy of the survey instrument and instructions may be found in Appendix C.

Definitions

Branch Office shall mean a location or site from which a home health agency provides services within a portion of the total geographic area served by the parent agency. The branch office is part of the home health agency and is located sufficiently close (within a fifty (50) mile radius) to share administration, supervision and services in a manner that renders it unnecessary to obtain a separate license as a home health agency. A branch office shall be staffed with at least one (1) registered nurse on a full-time basis.

Directly shall mean providing home health services through salaried employees of the home health agency or through personnel under hourly or per visit contracts or the equivalent. Where an hourly or per visit contract is made, Part V Section H must be followed to ensure adequate control and supervision by the home health agency.

Geographic Area shall mean the land area, for which the agency shall be licensed, consisting of not more than a fifty (50) mile radius surrounding the home health agency's office location. The geographic area shall be expressed in Mississippi counties.

Home Health Agency shall mean a public or privately owned agency or organization, or a subdivision of such an agency or organization, properly authorized to conduct business in Mississippi, which is primarily engaged in providing to individuals at the written direction of a licensed physician, in the individual's place of residence, skilled nursing services provided by or under the supervision of a Registered Nurse licensed to practice in Mississippi, and one or more of the following part-time or intermittent services or items:

- a. physical, occupational or speech therapy
- b. medical social services
- c. home health aide services
- d. other services as approved by the licensing agency
- e. medical supplies, other than drugs and biologicals, and the use of medical appliances
- f. medical services provided by a resident in training at a hospital under a teaching program of such hospital.

Parent Home Health Agency shall mean the agency that develops and maintains administrative control of sub-units and/or branches.

Patient's Residence shall mean the place where the patient makes his home, such as his own apartment or house, a relative's home but shall not include a hospital, nursing home or other extended care facility with the exception of services provided through outpatient therapy in a nursing home.

Skilled Nursing Services shall mean patient care services pertaining to the curative, restorative, and preventive aspects of nursing performed by or under the supervision of a registered nurse pursuant to the plan of treatment established in consultation with appropriate members of the care team. Skilled nursing service is nursing care emphasizing a high level of nursing direction, observation and skill.

Sub-Unit shall mean a semi-autonomous organization which serves patients in a geographic area different from that of the parent agency. A sub-unit shall be licensed separately from the parent agency and shall not have a branch office.

Map I Location of Home Health Agencies As of December 31, 1998





by Type of Agency



Chart II Percent of 1998 Home Health Patients by Method of Payment












