

Research and Data Analyst I

The MSDH STD/HIV Office seeks a Research and Data Analyst I to serve as Data Manager for the Medical Monitoring Project. The Medical Monitoring Project collects data on, and provides information about the behaviors, clinical outcomes, quality of care, and barriers to care and viral suppression among people with diagnosed HIV. The employee will be responsible for assessing the quality of data, resolving data errors, compiling monthly data management reports, performing data exports and providing data submissions.

Employee will be responsible for assisting in the development of forms, questionnaires, and other sampling techniques for data collection; assisting in preparing reports, graphs, data for publication, and tabular materials of a varying nature; and maintaining and adapting database and statistical programs.

Typically requires a bachelor's degree and 0-2 years of experience.
