



About the Position: The Mississippi State Department of Health is seeking to fill a Program Specialist III position in Hinds County.

Job Responsibilities: The Program Specialist III will be accountable for activities of a large and complex program focused around recruitment, onboarding and retention of public health employees. This position will be responsible for the planning, evaluation and management of projects that will support employee experience and retention activities. Employees at this level typically have specialized technical skills and can exercise a high degree of decision making and independence.
