

About the Position: The Mississippi State Department of Health is seeking to fill a Nurse III position within the Hinds County Health Department.

Job Responsibilities: Under the supervision of the District Operations Director, the County Coordinating Nurse is a supervisory Professional Registered Nurse accountable for serving as a member of the medical treatment team. Accountable for overseeing more complex or sensitive care, participating as a member of multidisciplinary team providing direct care in a patient care setting, or providing nursing and health services in a public health program. Will be responsible for mentoring or directing the work of subordinate employees. Will provide public health nursing services primarily within a county health department clinic. Duties may include conducting patient assessments, developing treatment plans, providing health education, referring patients to care, conducting disease control activities, performing direct patient care procedures, home visitation, and serving on emergency/disaster response teams.

To be Successful: Candidate should demonstrate good communication skills, leadership skills, customer service, must possess the ability to work well independently upon instruction, must have knowledge and skill to both perform and review the work that is overseen, and good rapport with patients and the public.
