

As a result of the adoption of the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 2014, child care staff residing in Mississippi seeking a child care background check must have the following checks completed:

- 1) A Mississippi criminal history record check.
- 2) A Mississippi sex offender registry or repository check.
- 3) A Mississippi Child Abuse and Neglect Registry check (see below link).
- 4) A National Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) criminal history check.
- 5) A National Crime Information Center (NCIC) sex offender registry check (NSOR).
- 6) An interstate Child Abuse and Neglect Registry check (if applicable)
- 7) An interstate criminal history check (if applicable)
- 8) An Interstate sex offender registry check (if applicable)

Please follow the below steps to request a Mississippi background check for employment in a Mississippi licensed, regulated, or registered child care facility.

- 1) The cost to process a background check is \$50.00 per applicant (extra cards and reprints on the same applicant do not require additional payment). All applications for background checks must be paid for and completed online at: www.safer.msdh.ms.gov.
- 2) The provider will create a new application on www.safer.msdh.ms.gov and the individual will submit a fingerprint card to the MSDH Criminal History Fingerprint unit either by mail OR if available in the surrounding area, schedule a LiveScan fingerprint at a local Health Department livescan site. If a LiveScan location is unavailable, complete ALL areas on a fingerprint card and mail to the below address. (Note: If a card is not complete, it will be returned and will result in delayed background check processing).

- 3) Complete the Mississippi Child Abuse and Neglect Registry DocuSign form. Click Here

- 4) Once fingerprints are received, they are processed thru MCIC and FBI, results are received back thru www.safer.msdh.ms.gov website. Both provider and applicants are notified via email.
