


Understanding the Annual Performance Report (APR)

- The APR is completed each year to summarize performance on indicators using data from the past FFY (Federal Fiscal Year)
 - Federal Fiscal Years run from July 1 to June 30.
 - Federal Fiscal Years are named for the calendar year in which they start (i.e., FFY2022 covers July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.)
- The key indicators focus on:
 - <u>Compliance</u> with timelines in IDEA (i.e., timely IFSP development, timely services, and timely transition). Targets are 100%.
 - <u>Results</u> on important outcomes for children and families (e.g., services in natural environments, child outcomes, family outcomes). Targets are set by the state, with stakeholder input.





Percent of eligible infants and toddlers with IFSPs for whom an initial evaluation/ assessment and initial IFSP meeting were conducted within the 45-day timeline



Percent of toddlers with disabilities exiting Part C with a transition plan (steps and services on IFSP) developed at least 90 days before the toddler's third birthday





Percent of toddlers with disabilities exiting Part C for whom the SEA and LEA where the toddler resides was notified at least 90 days before the toddler's third birthday





Percent of toddlers with disabilities exiting Part C for whom a transition conference was conducted (invited parties) at least 90 days before the toddler's third birthday




