## Wilderness and Remote First Aid

This course goes beyond basic "first aid." This course contains substantial medical information and teaches skills required for medical emergencies in the wild and trains participants to manage acute situations with limited resources. The goal is to provide instruction and training that leads to better decision-making that can save valuable time and human resources in the event help is not immediately available. The course integrates classroom instruction with scenario based learning.

This 2 day course provides essential knowledge needed when faced with a sudden injury or illness in a remote location, which could be a wilderness environment or urban disaster such as an earthquake, tornado or hurricane. It is designed for Search and Rescue teams, Public Safety Responders, scouts and scout leaders, outdoor enthusiasts or anyone who works or spends time in remote environments or austere conditions. This course teaches advanced skills to be used in emergencies when resources are limited and professional help may be far away or delayed. Get ready to improvise because your supplies will be limited.

### Topics Include:

- Patient assessment
- Chest injuries
- Shock
- Head/brain/spinal injuries
- Bone and joint injuries
- Wounds and wound infection
- Abdominal problems
- Hypothermia
- Heat problems
- Lightning
- Altitude illnesses
- Submersion incidents
- Allergies and anaphylaxis
- Wilderness first-aid kits
- Burns
- Scenarios and Improvisation

Course participants must be at least 15 years old.

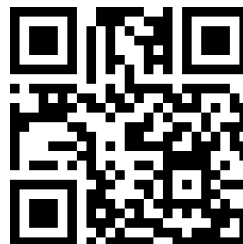
