We are pleased to report that our water meets all federal and state requirements.

NLWA draws its water via 5 wells from the Lower Wilcox aquifer at depths between approximately 450 and 650 feet. The Mississippi State Department of Health has performed a source water assessment for each well and these can be viewed at the NLWA main office. The water supply for North Lauderdale Water Association received a lower to moderate ranking for susceptibility to contamination.

The North Lauderdale Water Association routinely monitors for contaminants and constituents in our diffixing water according to Federal and State laws. This table below shows the results of our monitoring throughout cale and organic chemicals, and radioactive substances. All drinking water, including bottled drinking water, may be reasonably expected to contain at least small amounts of some constituents. The presence of these constituents in small amounts does not necessarily pose a health risk.
