These positions are responsible for providing prevention and control of sexually transmitted and other communicable diseases through field investigation. Work includes the investigation of confidential information pertaining to known and suspected cases of communicable diseases, collection of blood samples in the clinic or field setting, counseling patients and providing health education, consulting with physicians, nurses, and other health professionals aiding with cases, and maintaining surveillance of diagnosed infections.

Bachelor's degree and 0-2 years of experience in public health, health education, biology, psychology, social work, sociology or related field.
