

### "How DIABETES Affects Your ORAL HEALTH"




- People with diabetes are more susceptible to serious gum disease.
- Serious gum disease may make diabetes worse by affecting blood glucose control.

#### ORAL HEALTH PROBLEMS FROM DIABETES

- Periodontal (gum) Disease
- Thrush (Fungal infection)
- Dry Mouth
- Tooth Decay
- Delayed Healing
- Tooth Loss

### ORAL HEALTH AND DIABETES IN MISSISSIPPI ADULTS

- Approximately 17% of the population in Mississippi has diabetes.
- About 15% of the population in Mississippi with diabetes has lost all their permanent teeth.
- More female diabetics (55.8%) have lost six or more teeth than male diabetics (44.2%) with no racial differences noted between Whites and Blacks.
- Among Mississippi adults, those with diabetes show a significantly higher prevalence of having six or more missing teeth across all age groups, with the highest rates observed in individuals over 65.
