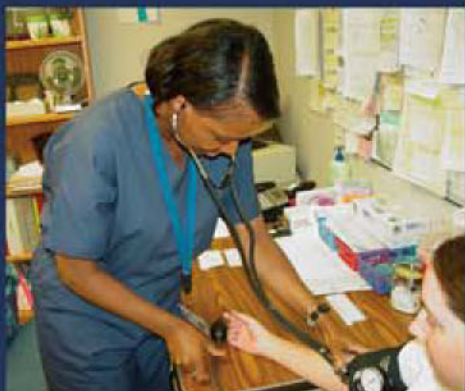

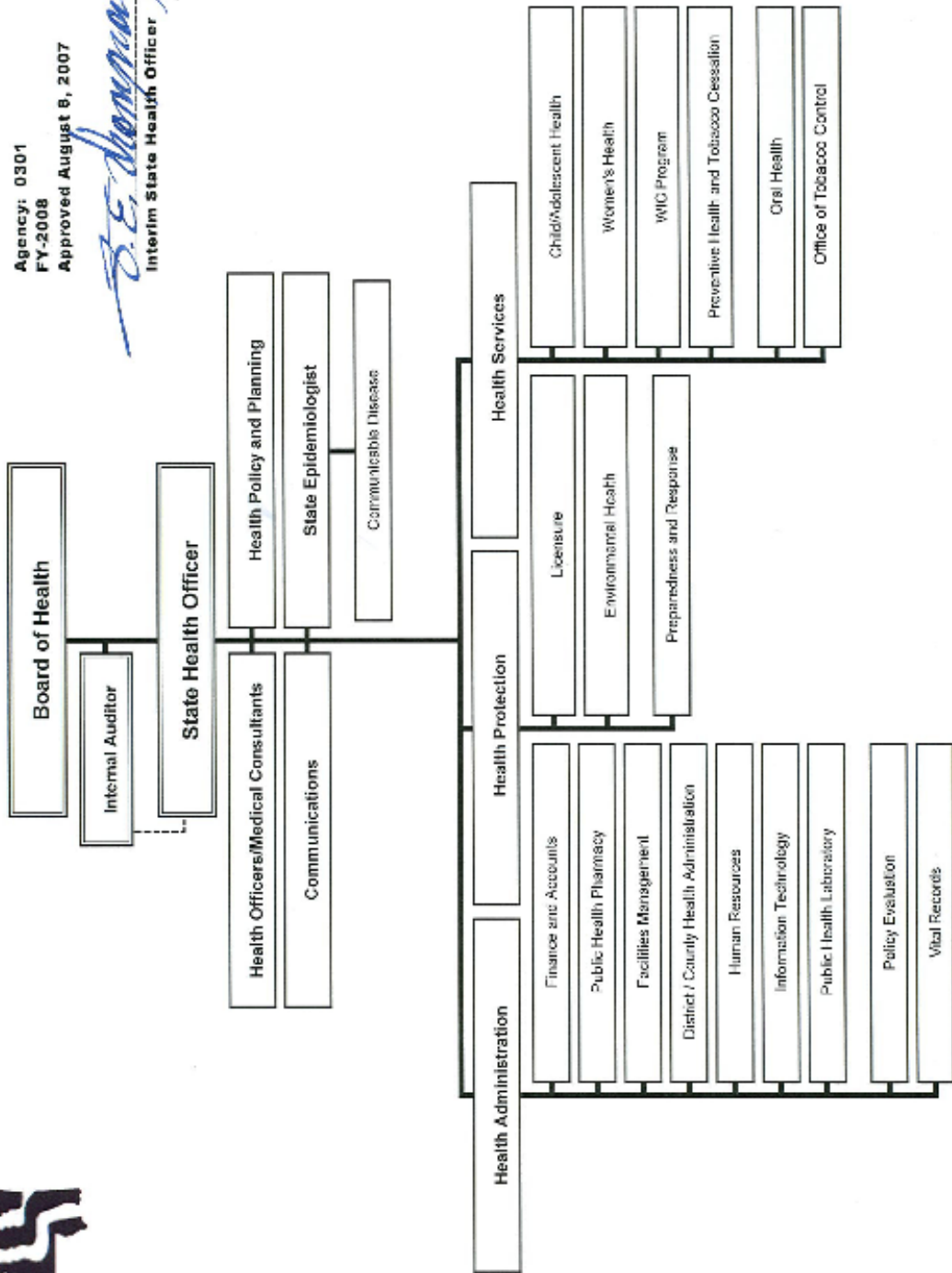
Mississippi State Department of Health Functional Organizational Chart

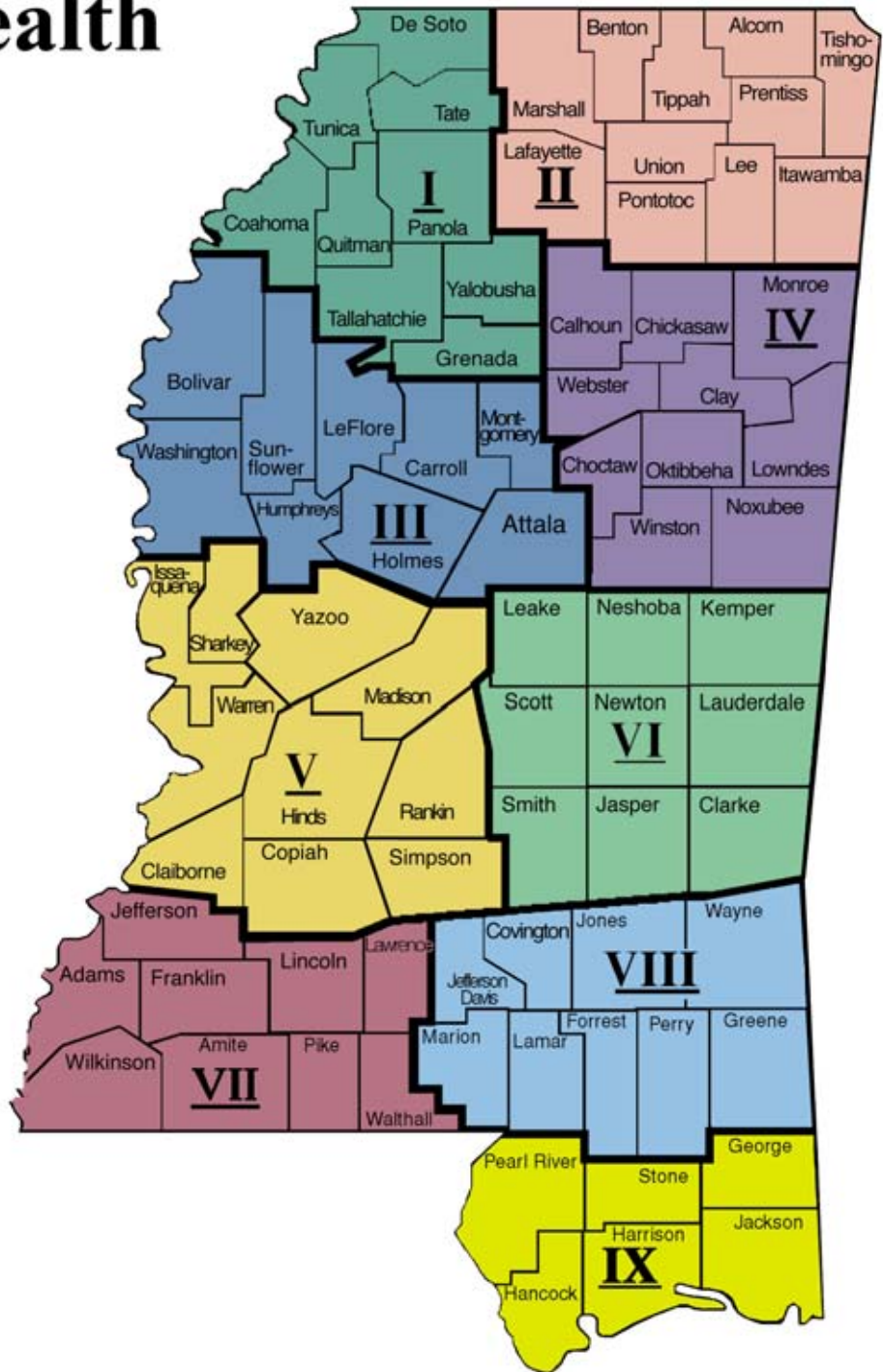

Changes in State Law

In FY 2007, Senate Bill 2764 abolished the State Board of Health effective March 30, 2007, and the position of the State Health Officer on June 30, 2007. Senate Bill 2764 reinstated the State Board of Health, the new position of State Health Officer, and the Department effective July 1, 2007. Senate Bill 2764 also created the Office of Tobacco Control at the Department to develop and implement a comprehensive and statewide tobacco education, prevention and cessation program effective March 30, 2007. Senate Bill 2764 extended the new Board of Health, the new position of State Health Officer, and the Department until June 30, 2010.

Changes in Regulations

The only regulatory actions taken by the State Board of Health in FY 2007 were taken at the July 2006 meeting, and they are as follows:

Adopted the Implementation Schedule -FY 2007 Water Quality Analysis Fee

Adopted revisions to the J-1 Visa Application Guidelines for Primary Care and Specialist Physicians.

These changes remove requiring a J-1 foreign-medical graduate to complete two years of service obligation prior to receiving a National Interest Waiver letter from MSDH and increased application processing fee.

Adopted revisions to the Certificate of Need Review Manual.

These changes reflect statutory changes in certificate of need program, change in program fee structure, including addition of fees and other non-substantive changes.

Adopted revisions to the Regulations Governing Licensure of Child Care Facilities.

These changes add additional exemption from licensure and clarify the process to request an exemption from licensure; further, a requirement was added to allow breast-feeding in child care facilities.

Adopted revisions to the Regulations Governing Licensure of Child Care Facilities for 12 or fewer Children in the Operator's Home.

These changes add additional exemption from licensure and clarify the process to request an exemption from licensure; further, a requirement was added to allow breast-feeding in child care facilities.

Adopted revisions to the Minimum Standards of Operation for Ambulatory Surgical Facilities.

These changes revise the requirement for review and reappointment of each medical staff member to every three years from every two years.

Adopted revisions to the Minimum Standards of Operation for Hospice.

These changes amend the definition of terminally ill from one year to six months or less of life expectancy.

Adopted revisions to the Reportable Disease and Conditions.

These changes conform the reportable disease and conditions with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations for the reporting of disease agents and conditions that have terrorism potential.

Adopted revisions to the Mississippi Food Regulations.

This adds regulations for the assessment of an administrative fine for operation of a food facility without a permit.

During FY 2007 the Board also adopted the FY 2007 Mississippi State Health Plan, approved by the Governor effective November 12, 2006.

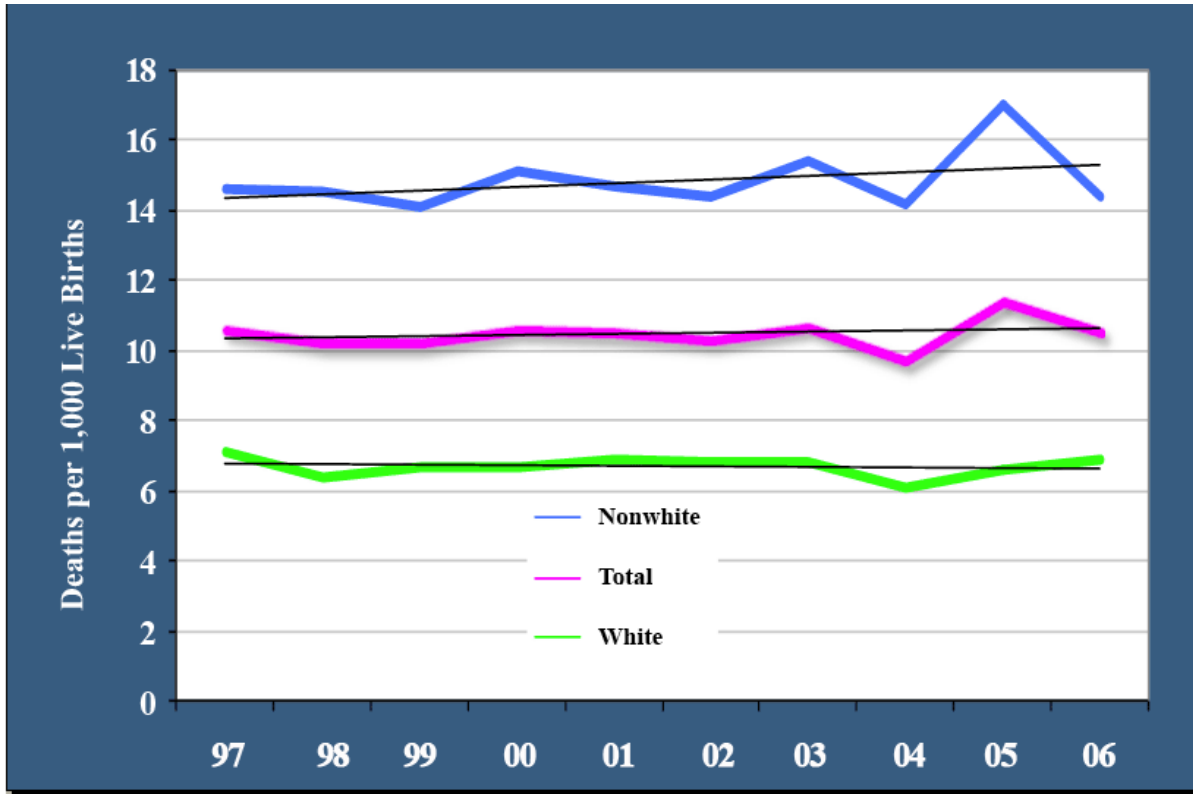

Infant Mortality Rate – Mississippi 2006

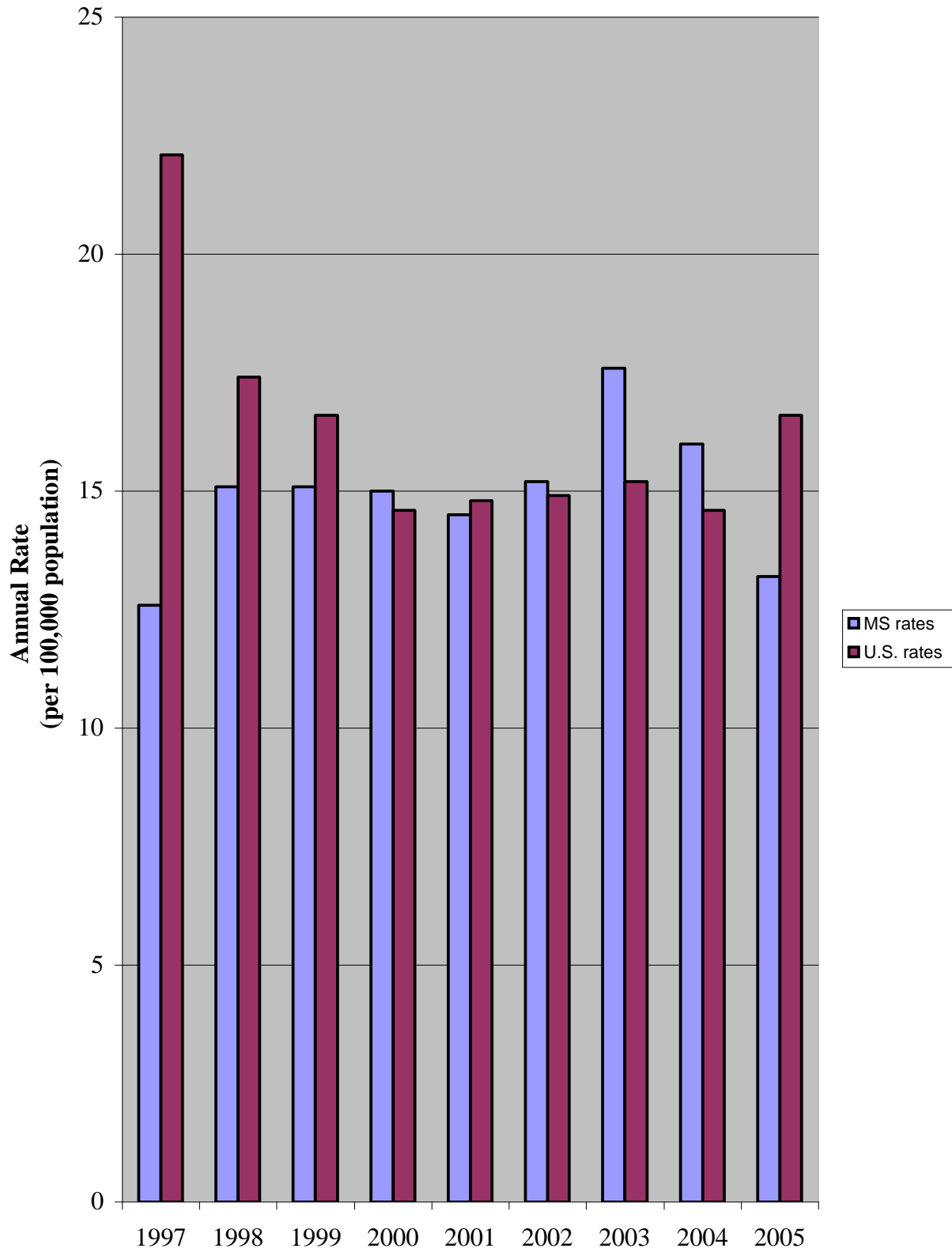

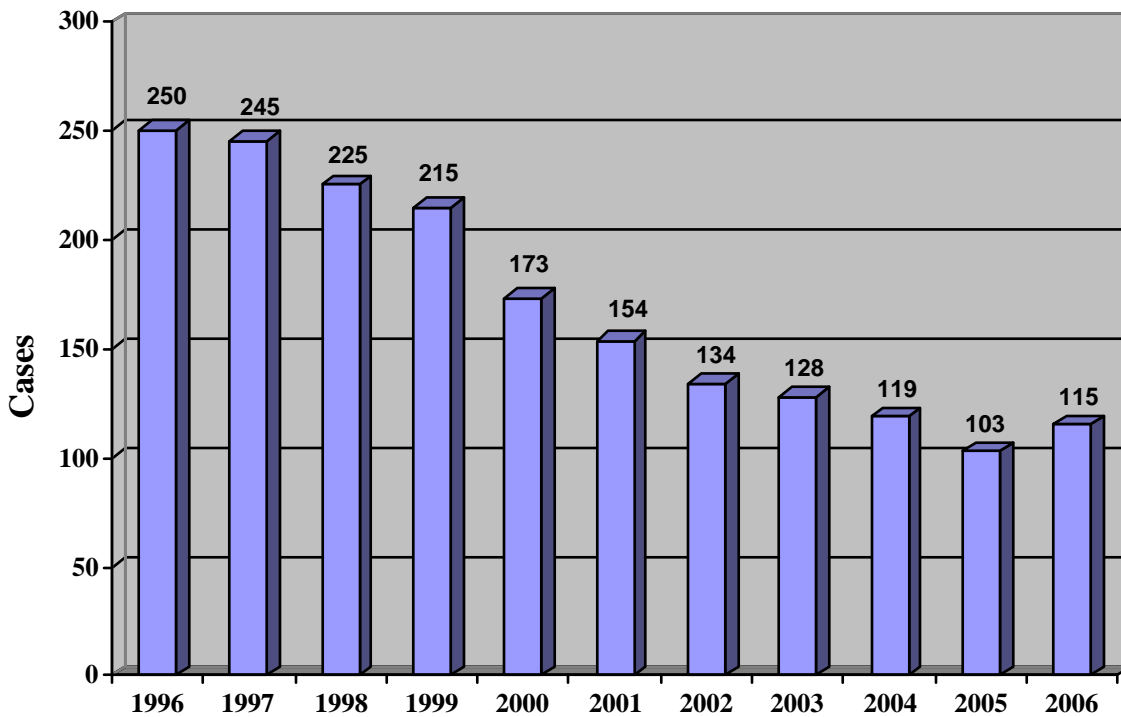

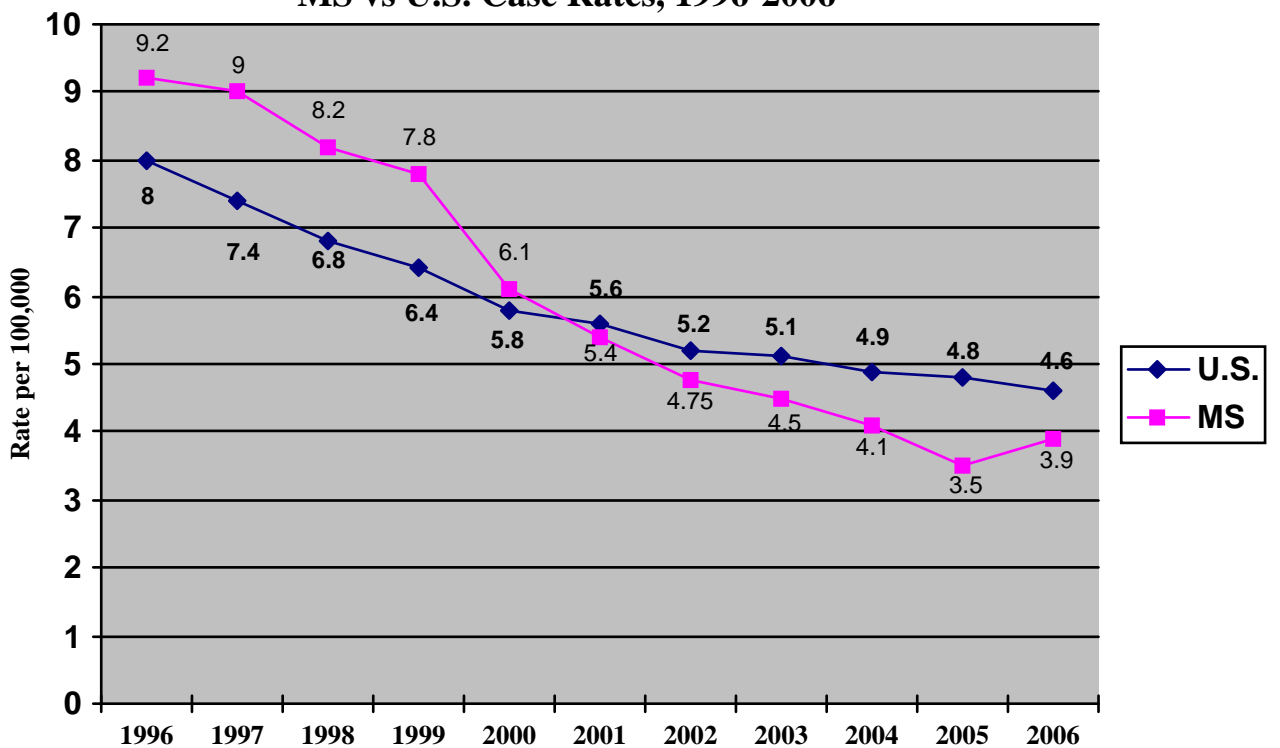
AIDS Annual Rates for the U.S. and Mississippi, 1997-2005



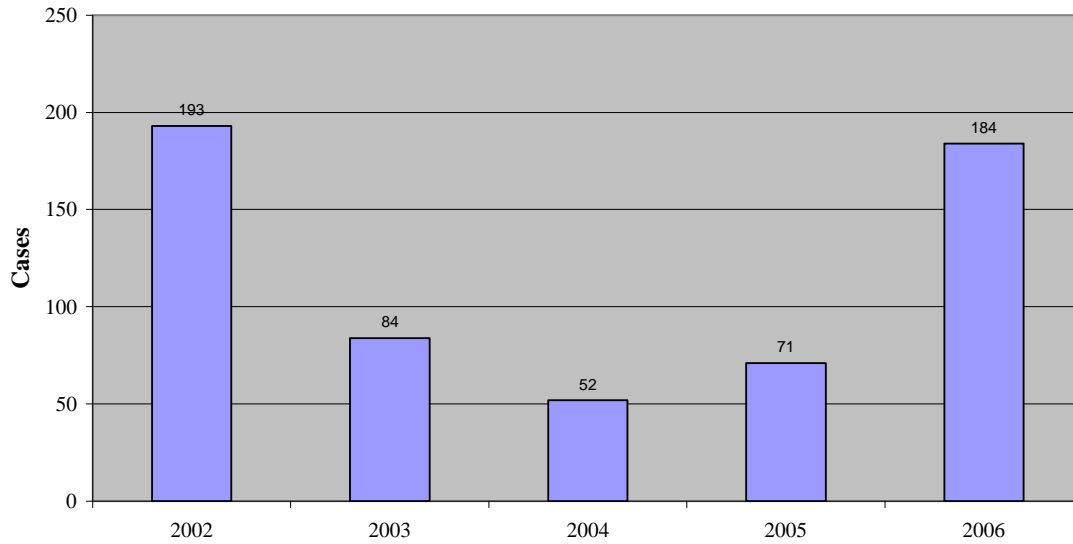
MS Reported Tuberculosis Cases 1996 - 2006



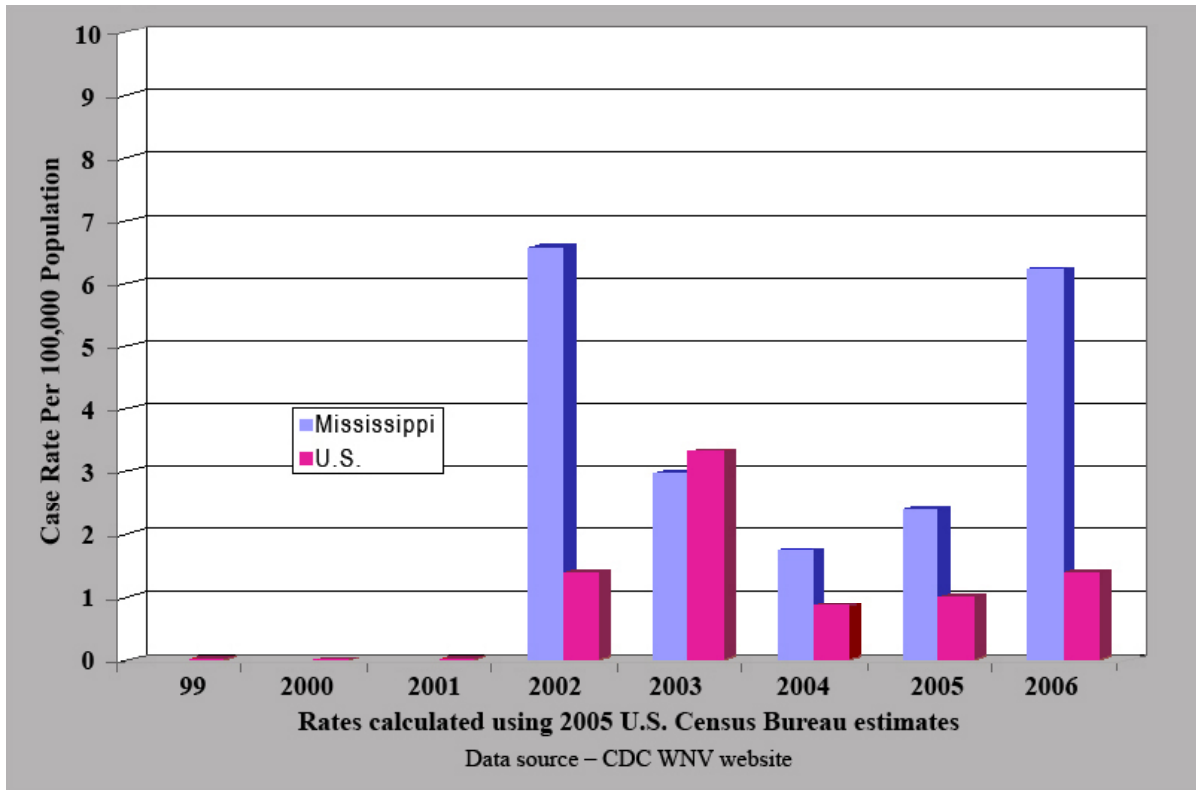
Tuberculosis Case Rates MS vs U.S. Case Rates, 1996-2006



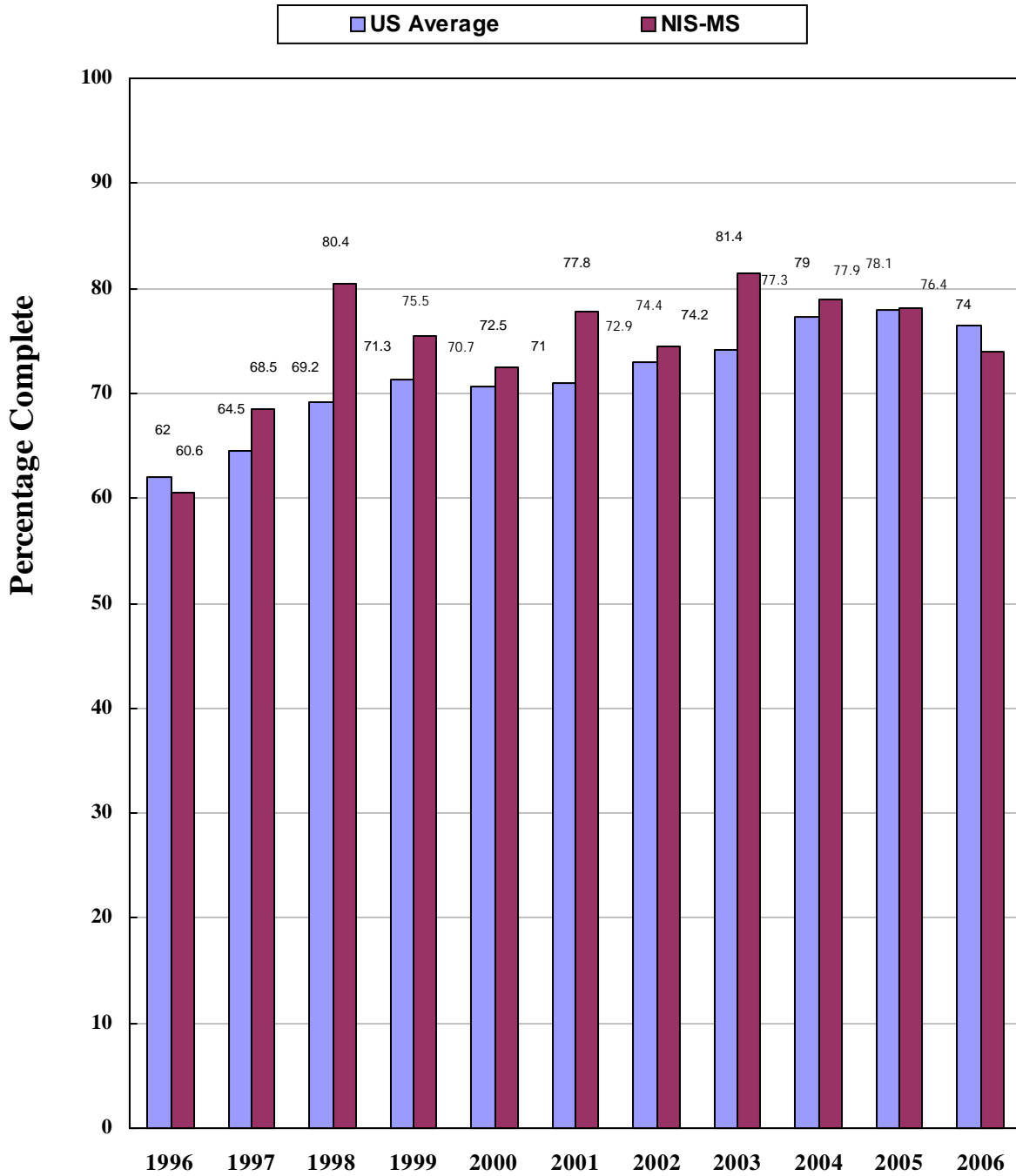
West Nile Virus Cases in MS 2002-2006

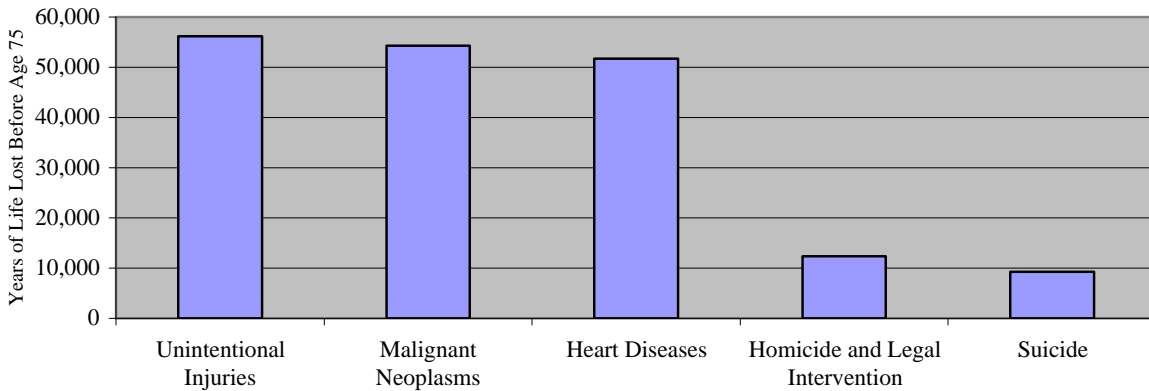

Mississippi Residents, 2006**



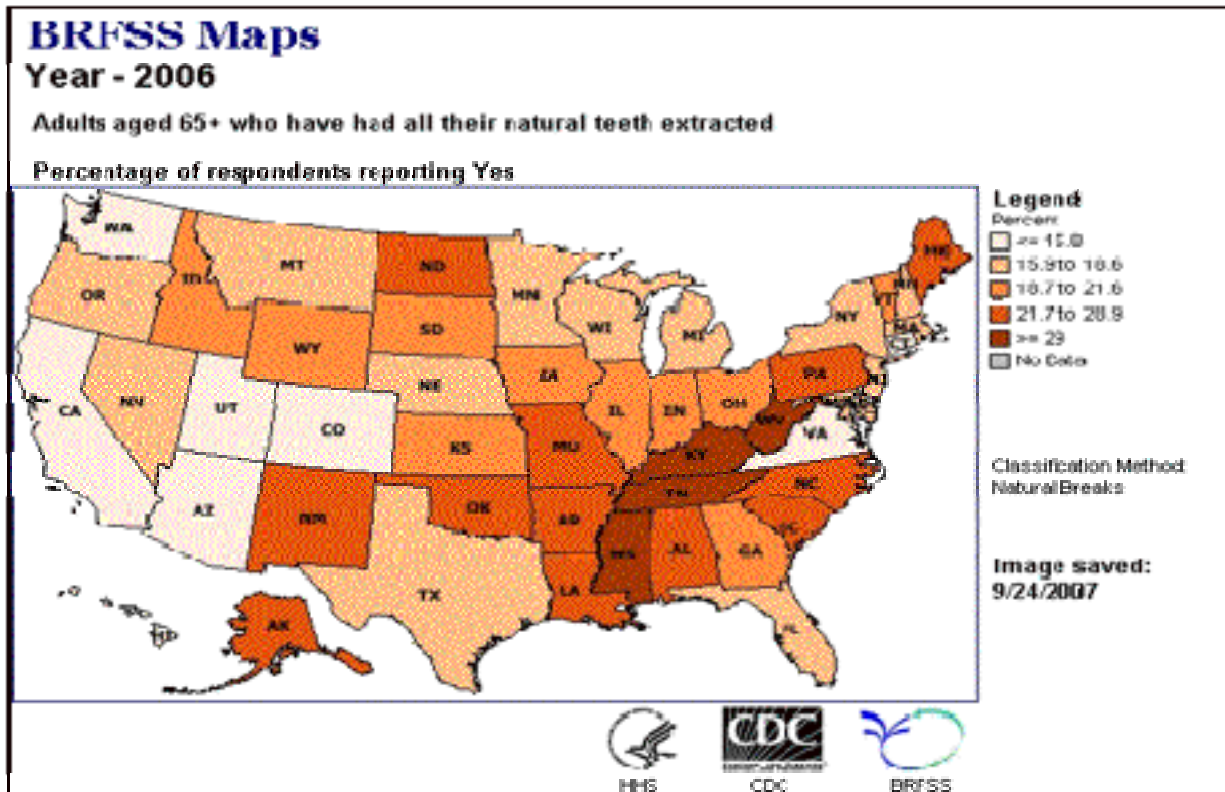

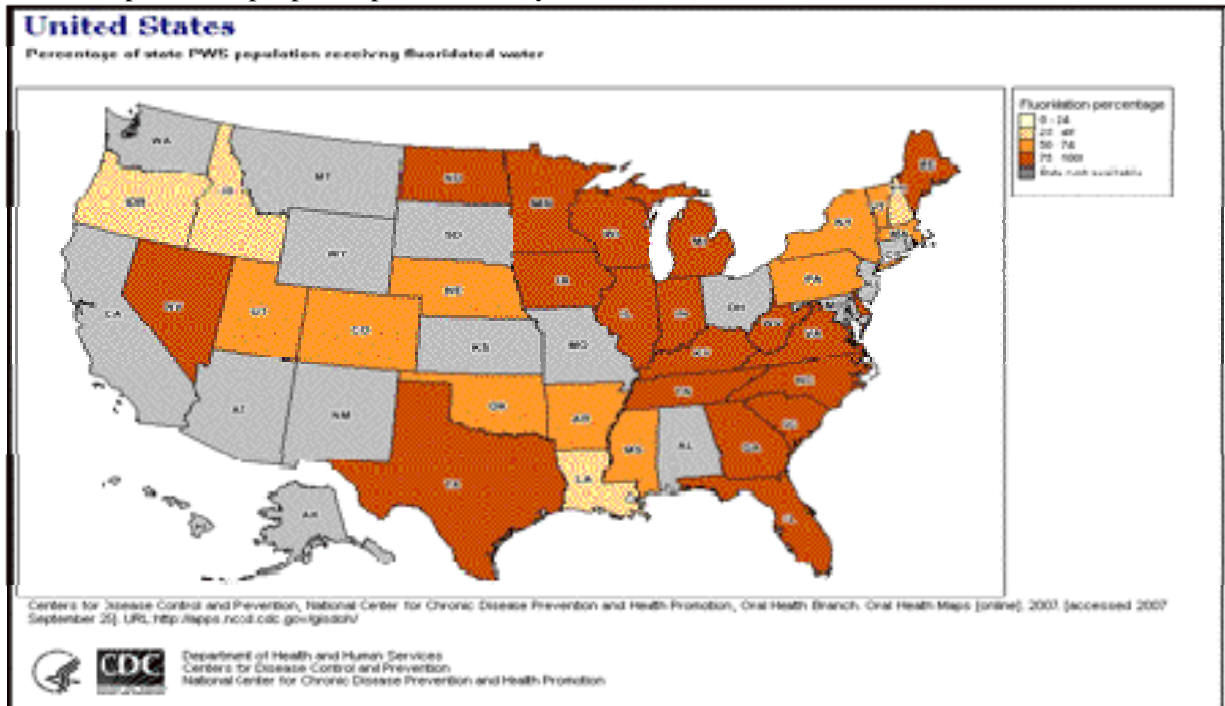

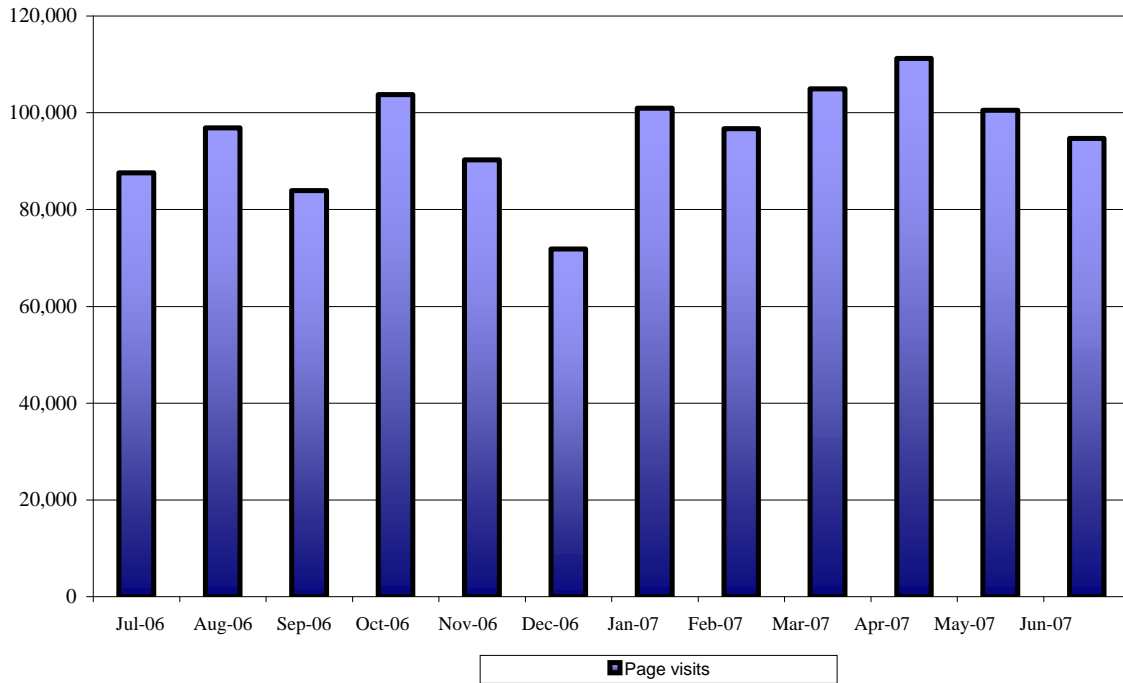
Oral Health 2006



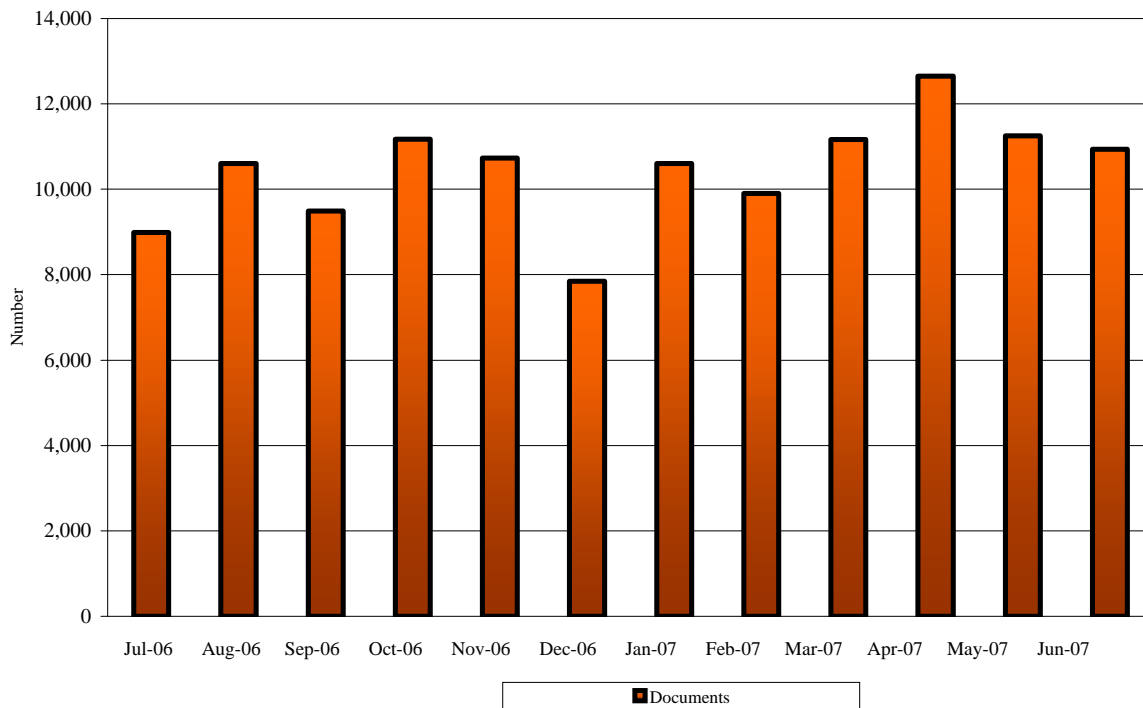
Proportion of people on public water systems (PWS) that receive water fluoridation in 2007

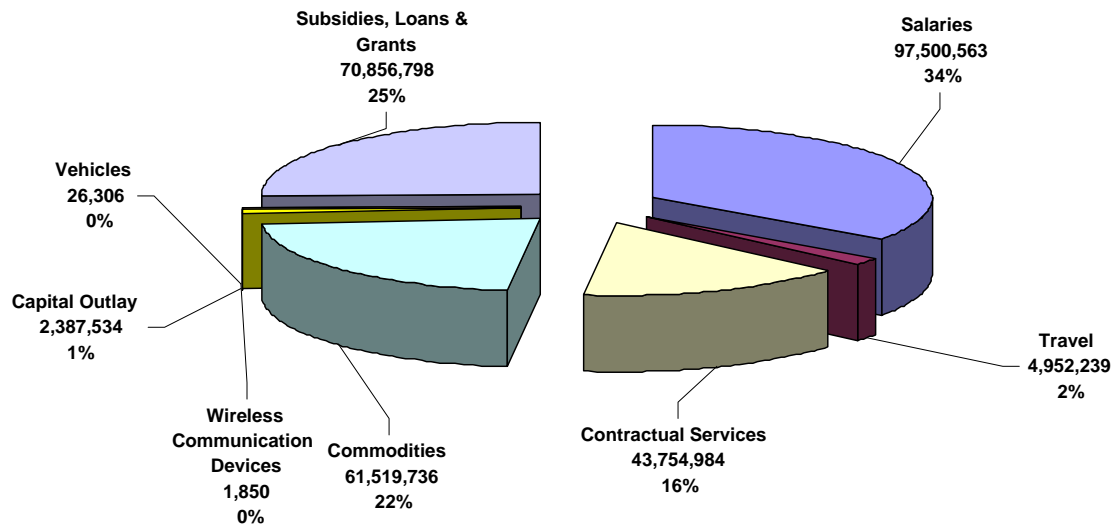

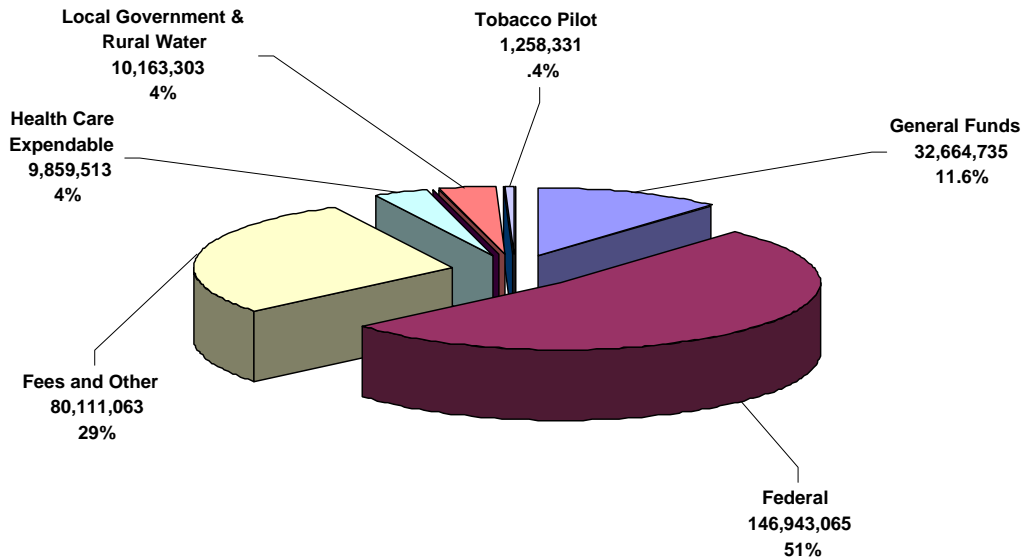

Funding Sources for Fiscal Year 2007 Expenditures

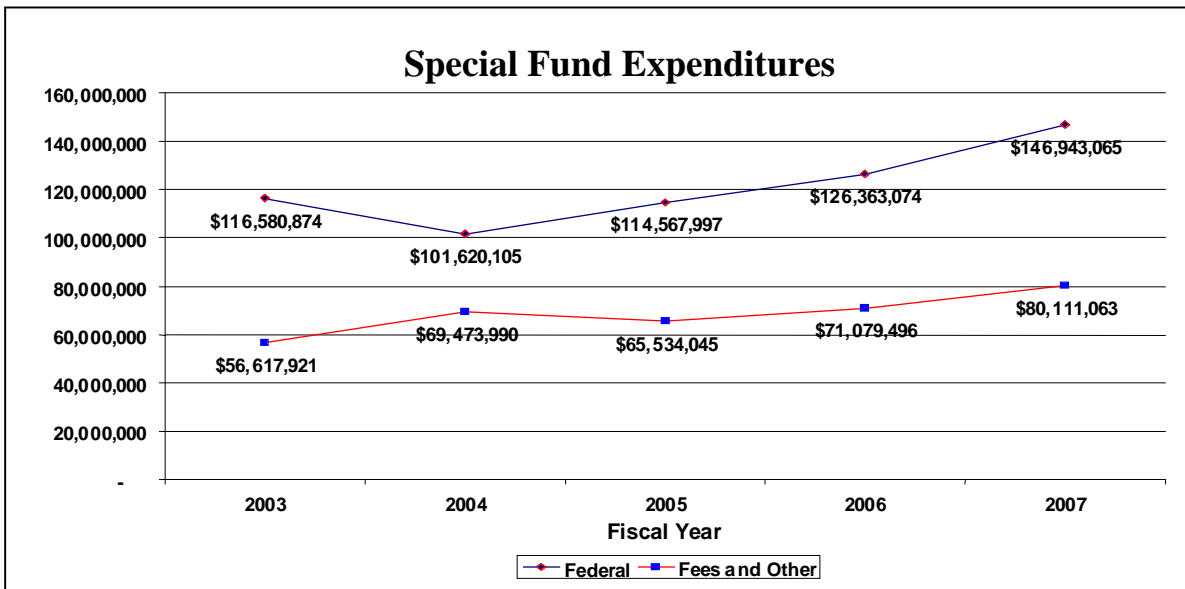
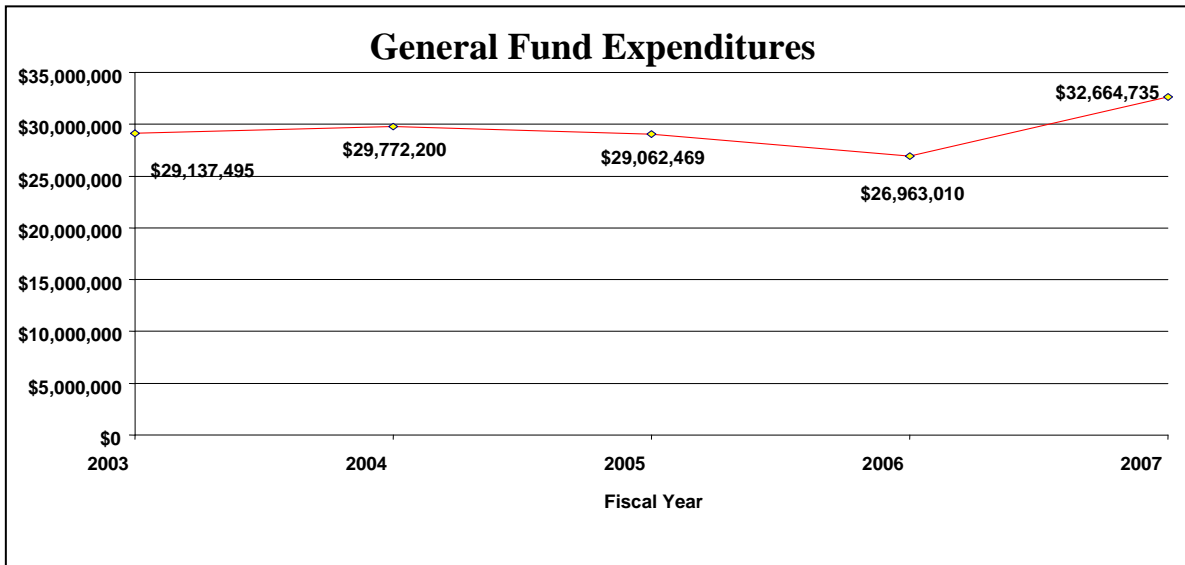
