- Providing leadership in the implementation of agency policies.

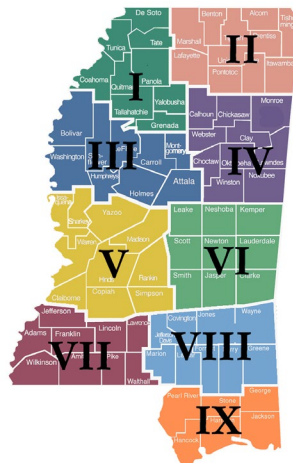
Minimum qualifications:
