

## Your antigen (rapid) test is negative.

- > If you are symptomatic, continue to isolate until you receive your PCR test result.
- ➤ If you are **asymptomatic** and have been **exposed** to a person with COVID-19, monitor for symptoms and wear a mask around people for 10 days even if your PCR test is negative.

You will receive an email from your UMMC portal with your test results as soon as they are available (typically 3-5 days).

## If you are symptomatic, follow these instructions:

- If your PCR result returns positive, you are a case. Continue to isolate for at least 5 days. See <a href="https://msdh.ms.gov/file/9915.pdf">https://msdh.ms.gov/file/9915.pdf</a> for Isolation Instructions.
- If your PCR result returns negative, stay at home until symptoms improve and fever free for 24 hours.

## If you are a contact to a case, follow these instructions:

- If your PCR result returns positive, you are a case. You need to isolate from the date your test was collected. See <a href="https://msdh.ms.gov/file/9915.pdf">https://msdh.ms.gov/file/9915.pdf</a> for Isolation Instructions.
