Responsible for short to medium term objectives and outcomes and works under the general guidance and advice of their supervisor or a more senior team member. At this level, employees are contributing team members and present recommendations and build on the ideas of others within and outside of their discipline. Employees in this family have significant public interaction.

The Public Health Environmental Officer II- The staff works under the supervision of Division Director II (Field Services Director) and is responsible for helping with STD PCHD Work Plan management and preparation of related reports. The staff assists the Director in addressing PRISM user training needs. The staff provides content expertise on STD/HIV field related issues including laboratory interpretation, PRISM documentation, and appropriate STD case management.
