VIOLATIONS FROM INSPECTIONS IN 2019

Every year the MSDH Division of Food Protection-Manufactured Food conducts inspection audits to determine the most marked violations from the previous year. For 2019 most violations concerned general sanitation of processing and storage areas, including plants and grounds, equipment and utensils, and sanitary operations.

QUALIFIED FACILITY ATTESTATION FOR HUMAN FOOD FACILITY

A business that meets the definition of a “qualified facility” is subject to modified requirements of the preventive controls rules. These modified requirements can be met by submitting a form to FDA, attesting to the business’s status as a qualified facility and attesting that the facility is implementing preventive controls to address hazards associated with its food or is in compliance with non-Federal food safety laws and regulations. Unless you have attested FDA can conduct a full scope preventive controls inspection at any time.
