About the Position: The Office of Women's Health, Healthy Moms/Healthy Babies (HM/HB) Program of Mississippi is seeking one (1) Nurse Team Lead position. This position will be the Public Health District VI Nurse Team Lead for the program. This position will provide supervision to Nurse Case Managers. The Nurse Team Lead will provide oversight of HM/HB staff in all counties of the assigned Public Health District. Will assure all nursing staff is trained properly and training is documented meeting the requirement for Medicaid reimbursement. Will oversee the monthly reporting of caseload statistics and productivity measures of the HM/HB field staff. Monitors the volume of services provided and works with staff to adjust county-level caseloads as needed. Assures adequate transfer of information is provided related to key performance indicators for all staff under supervision. Provides consultation to county staff providing targeted case management for high-risk maternity and infant patients, including assuring adequate compliance with program standards for maternal and infant comprehensive assessments, nursing assessments, nutrition assessments, health education, and referrals to extended service providers. Provides outreach to medical providers and community stakeholders on the program's referral process. The position may also require the direct provision of targeted case management services, screenings, assessments, care plans, community outreach and care coordination to expectant mothers, infants up to 1 year of age and families in the program. These services are delivered in home and clinic settings.

Salary: \$65,774.65

Location: This position will at a minimum be responsible for supervision/management of counties in Public Health District VI: Leake, Scott, Smith, Jasper, Clarke, Lauderdale, Kemper, Newton, and Neshoba. Base is presently located in Leake County.

Qualifications: Registered nurse and at least 2-4 year's relevant work experience.
