The Mississippi State Department of Health, Child and Adolescent Health Program is seeking to fill a Public Health Program Specialist Supervisor position. This is The Part C State Coordinator for the Early Intervention (EI) Program. The employee administers the statewide Early Intervention system including: Monitoring federal and state Part C requirements and supporting best practices to maintain a high quality statewide early intervention program.

Serving as the point of contact for the Federal Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) to enhance the Part C Program. Ensuring the provision of technical assistance to the local Early Intervention Program Coordinators. Communicating to external stakeholders regarding Part C. Legislative duties pertaining to Part C, including presentations to the Mississippi State Legislature, State Interagency Coordinating Council and other entities as requested by Mississippi State Department of Health's (MSDH) Leadership. Providing updates to the MSDH Leadership on Part C initiatives. Creating the annual federal Part C Performance Report in collaboration with the EI MITI Coordinator/Manager. Representing Early Intervention in national-level technical assistance meetings and programs. Convening the ICC stakeholder group to guide early intervention policies and practices in Mississippi. Planning and facilitating the implementation of evidence based statewide practices. Overseeing early intervention professional development for the entire Part C team.
