**The Mississippi State Department of Health's Office of Tuberculosis and Refugee Health is seeking to fill Public Health Environmental Officer vacancies at the Leflore County and the Harrison County Health Departments.**

The Public Health Environmental Officer interviews known and suspected cases of TB and elicits pertinent information including obtaining names and locating information of contacts, suspects, and associates. Conducts cluster and field investigations to assist in the epidemiological investigation process, and when indicated, provides extensive re-interviews to locate the source case of disease. Maintains timely and accurate documentation in the patient record. Locates as needed and advises index case and contacts of appropriate diagnostic facilities and procedures for prompt intervention and examinations. Conducts activities before and after normal business hours. Performs venipuncture according to CLIA standards. Provides health education counseling to patients. Provides technical assistance and educational services to patients in a field setting. Completes required mandatory courses of training. Performs other duties as assigned.

Typically requires a Bachelor's Degree and 2-4 years of experience. Hourly pay rate ranges from \$14.96 to \$19.63.
