**The Mississippi State Department of Health's Office of STD/HIV is seeking to fill a Public Health Program Specialist vacancy.**

The Public Health Program Specialist serves as the **Education and Testing Coordinator** and will plan, develop, manage, and evaluate HIV counseling, testing, and referral (CTR) programming in high prevalence settings and settings serving populations at increased behavioral or clinical risk. The employee will work to improve the integration of HIV CTR and will collaborate with other staff for referral planning and management as part of continuum of care systems development. The staff will be responsible for performing site visits to implement and monitor HIV testing at healthcare sites. Other tasks will include generating testing activity reports for review; provide technical assistance to contracted testing sites; provide community outreach; provide fiscal management; coordinate distribution of testing supplies to testing sites; and submit interim and annual progress reports.

Typically requires a Bachelor's Degree in a health or science related background and 4+ years of experience.
