**The Mississippi State Department of Health's Office of STD/HIV is seeking to fill a Public Health Program Specialist vacancy.**

The Public Health Program Specialist serves as the **Training Coordinator** and will manage education and training for HIV testing personnel and other HIV prevention activities to MSDH staff and other health care professionals. The individual will also assist with education programs for HIV consumers, external community partners, and the public. Tasks include the identification of knowledge and skills gaps, selection and implementation of education and training tools based on an understanding of the trainee learning styles and abilities, maintaining a training database that includes enrollment and participation data, and oversight of training policies and rules. The employee will be responsible for developing and maintaining quarterly reports, progress reports, and for providing technical assistance to community partners. The employee will respond to requests for educational material and condoms and public inquiries.

Typically requires a Bachelor's Degree in a health or science related background and 4+ years of experience.
