Position Details:

The Mississippi State Department of Health's Maternal and Infant Health Bureau (MIHB) is seeking to fill a Certified Nurse (RN or Higher) contract position. This position will be part-time and will serve as the Fetal and Infant Mortality Review (FIMR) Program Liaison. The nurse will be responsible for serving as a liaison for new and existing FIMR teams in the Mississippi Delta.

Roles and Responsibilities

The FIMR Program Liaison responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

- Maintaining CRT (Case Review Team) Rosters
- Maintaining CAT (Community Action Team) rosters and membership
- Reviewing and/or abstracting FIMR records
- Scheduling and/or attending CRT & CAT meetings
- Facilitating CRT meetings (as needed)
- Maintaining confidentiality and protecting privacy of cases
- Acting as a liaison to external FIMR programs and other Maternal and Infant Health Coalitions
- Submitting reports as required by MIHB and/or MSDH
- Compiling findings and/or recommendations as needed
- Disseminating information to internal and external stakeholders as needed

Salary Range: \$36.58/hour (number of hours per week may vary **not to exceed 80 hours/month**)
