Job Responsibilities: The Nurse Team Leads (Chief Nurses) are responsible for monitoring county health departments within an assigned district area to ensure nursing services are provided in accordance with applicable program standards and agency policies and within the scope of the MS Nurse Practice Act. Provides guidance and instructions to nursing staff within a district area regarding public health care and standards and practices. Plans, directs, and coordinates the activities of district level nursing staff. Plans, directs, and coordinates training of nurses and nurse aides within assigned district. Assists with recruitment and hiring of staff. Advises district and regional administrative staff regarding implementation of agency program standards and policies. Other duties as assigned.

To be Successful: Candidate should have excellent multitasking, organizational, and communication skills. Employees must prioritize work to meet deadlines and be an effective team player. Need to have knowledge if MSDH programs and use that knowledge effectively to assist clients and/or patients as needed.
