

About the Position: The Mississippi State Department of Health, Southern Public Health Region, is seeking to fill a Nurse III (Family Planning Nurse) vacancy in District VIII, based in Hattiesburg, MS.

Job Responsibilities: This Nurse III (Family Planning Nurse) will need to be a seasoned professional Registered Nurse accountable for serving as a member of the medical treatment team. Accountable for overseeing more complex or sensitive care, participating as a member of multidisciplinary team providing direct care in a patient care setting, or providing nursing and health services in a public health program. May be responsible for mentoring or directing the work of lower-level employees. This position will provide technical assistance/consultation to county staff; assists Chief Nurse by sharing information and improving MSDH services; responds promptly to inquiries requiring resolution or response; reviews and conducts follow-up as necessary; orients staff to family planning services; works family planning clinics; manages clinic BCCP program; serves as resource for family planning questions and issues.

To be Successful: Candidate should have excellent multitasking, organizational, and communication skills. Employees must prioritize work to meet deadlines and be an effective team player. Need to have knowledge of MSDH programs and use that knowledge effectively to assist clients and/or patients as needed.
