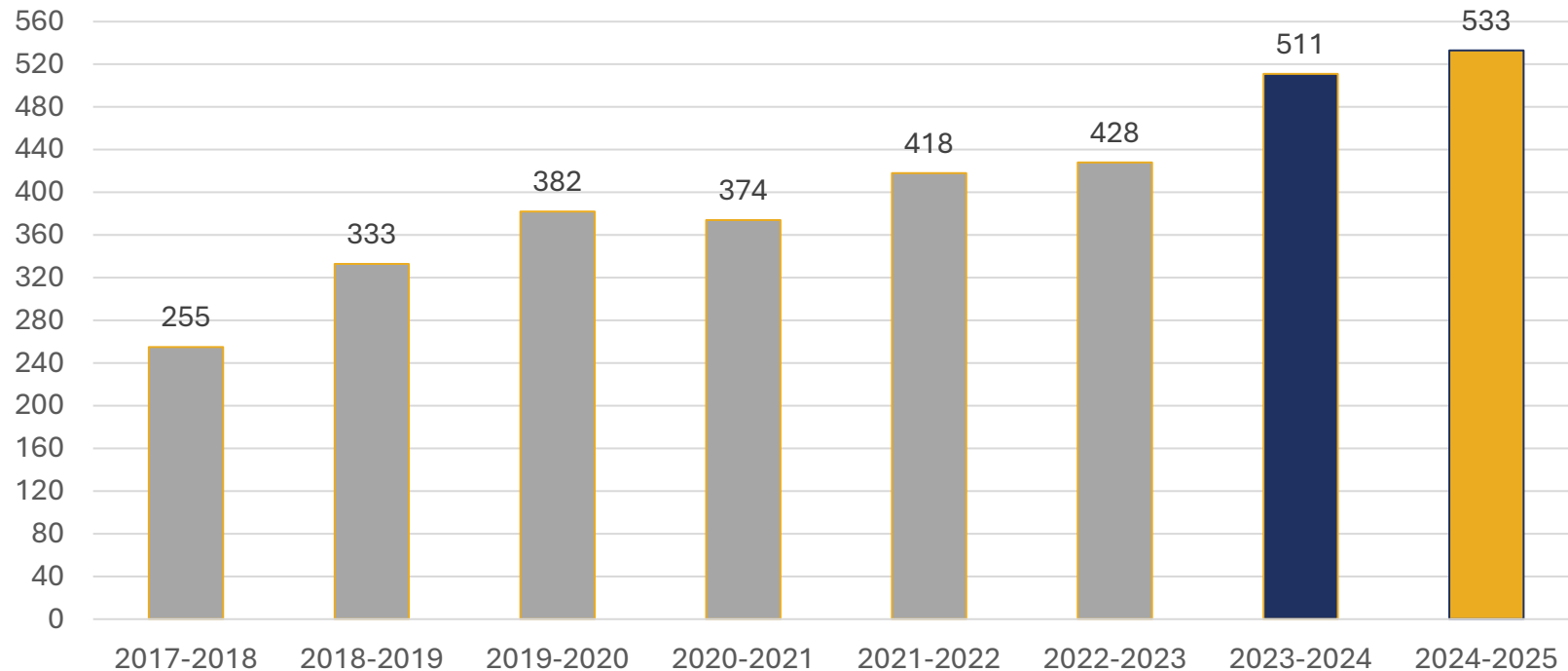

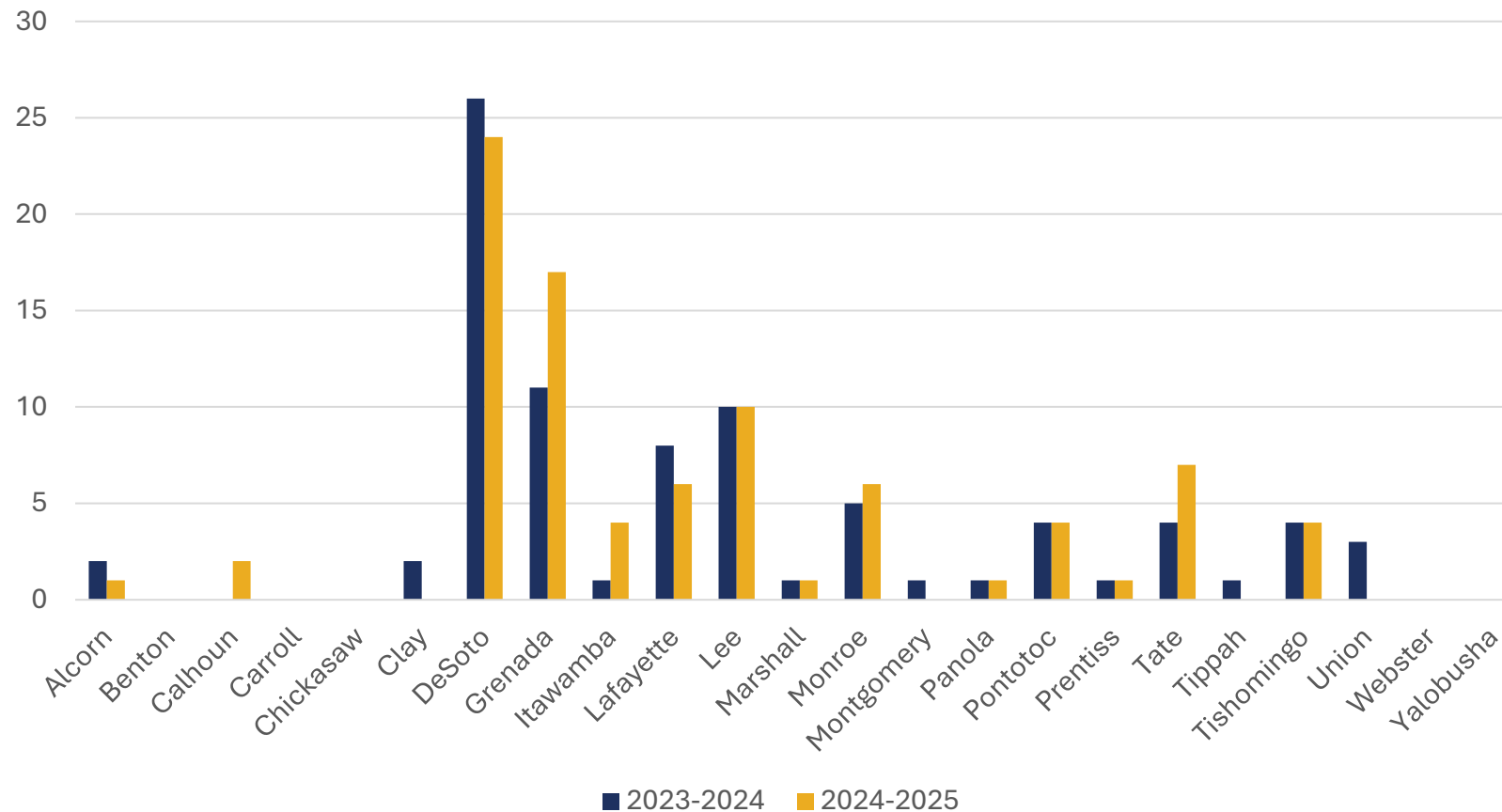
Mississippi 2024-2025 School Medical Exemptions By Year, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten-12th Grade

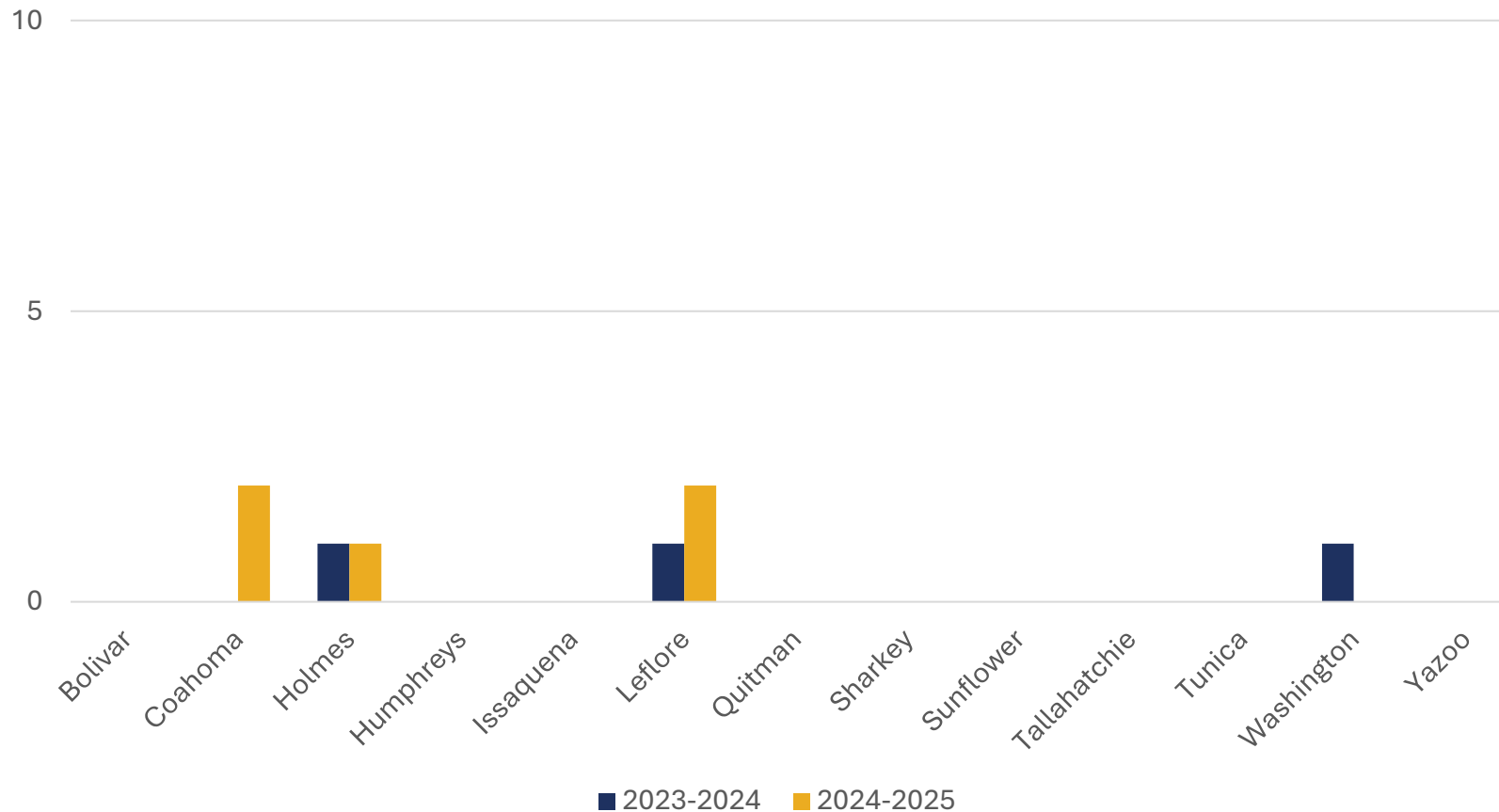
School Medical Exemptions Granted by Year & County, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12th Grade

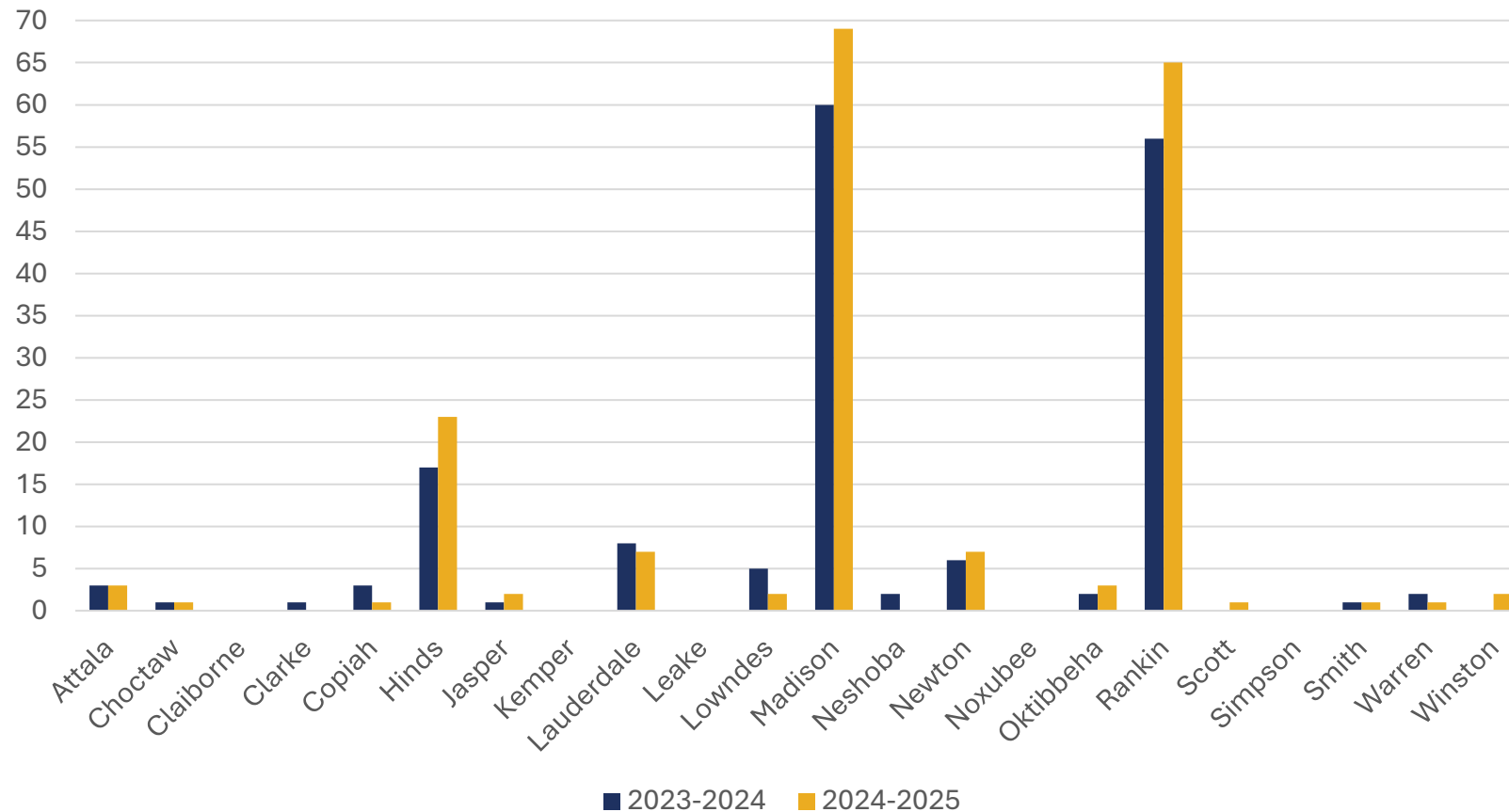
School Medical Exemptions Granted by Year & County, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12th Grade

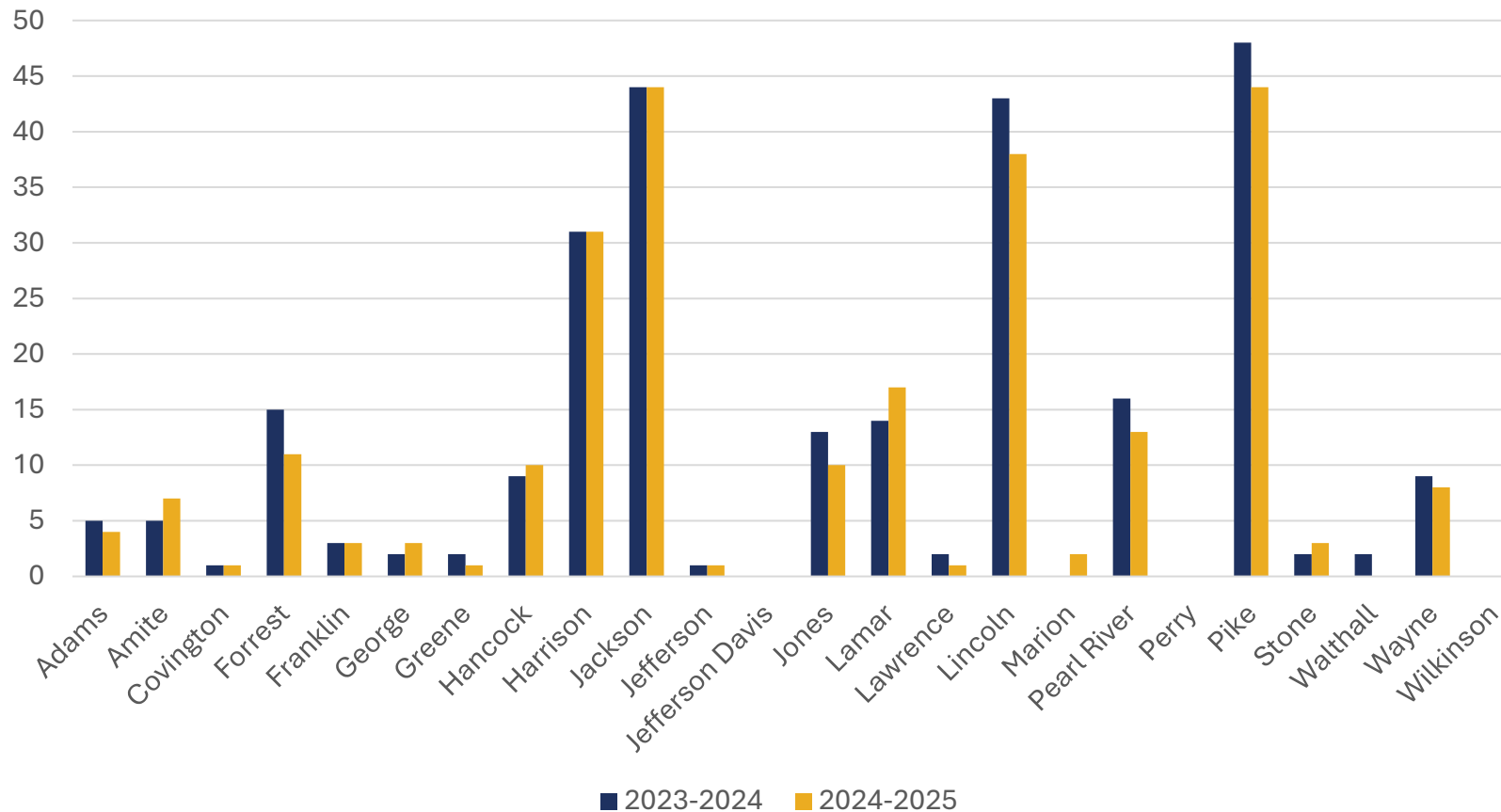
School Medical Exemptions Granted by Year & County, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12th Grade



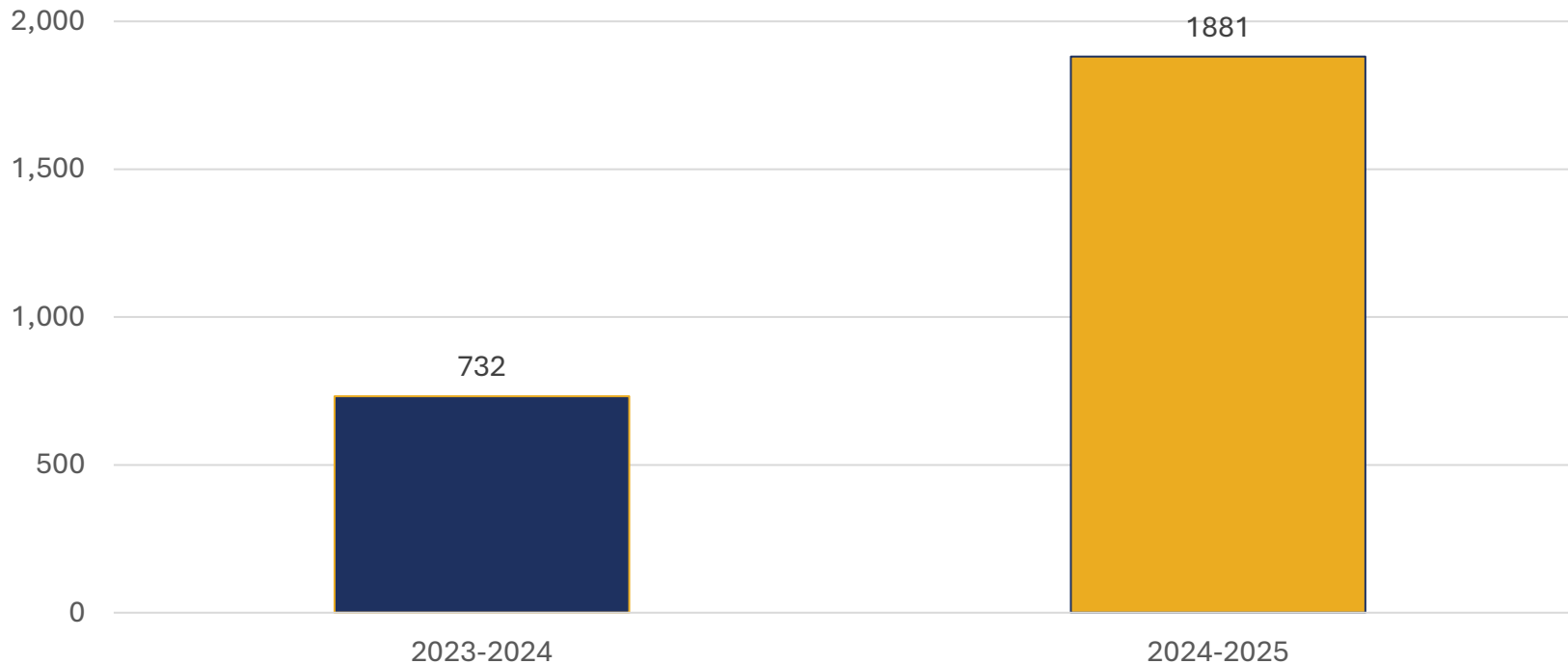

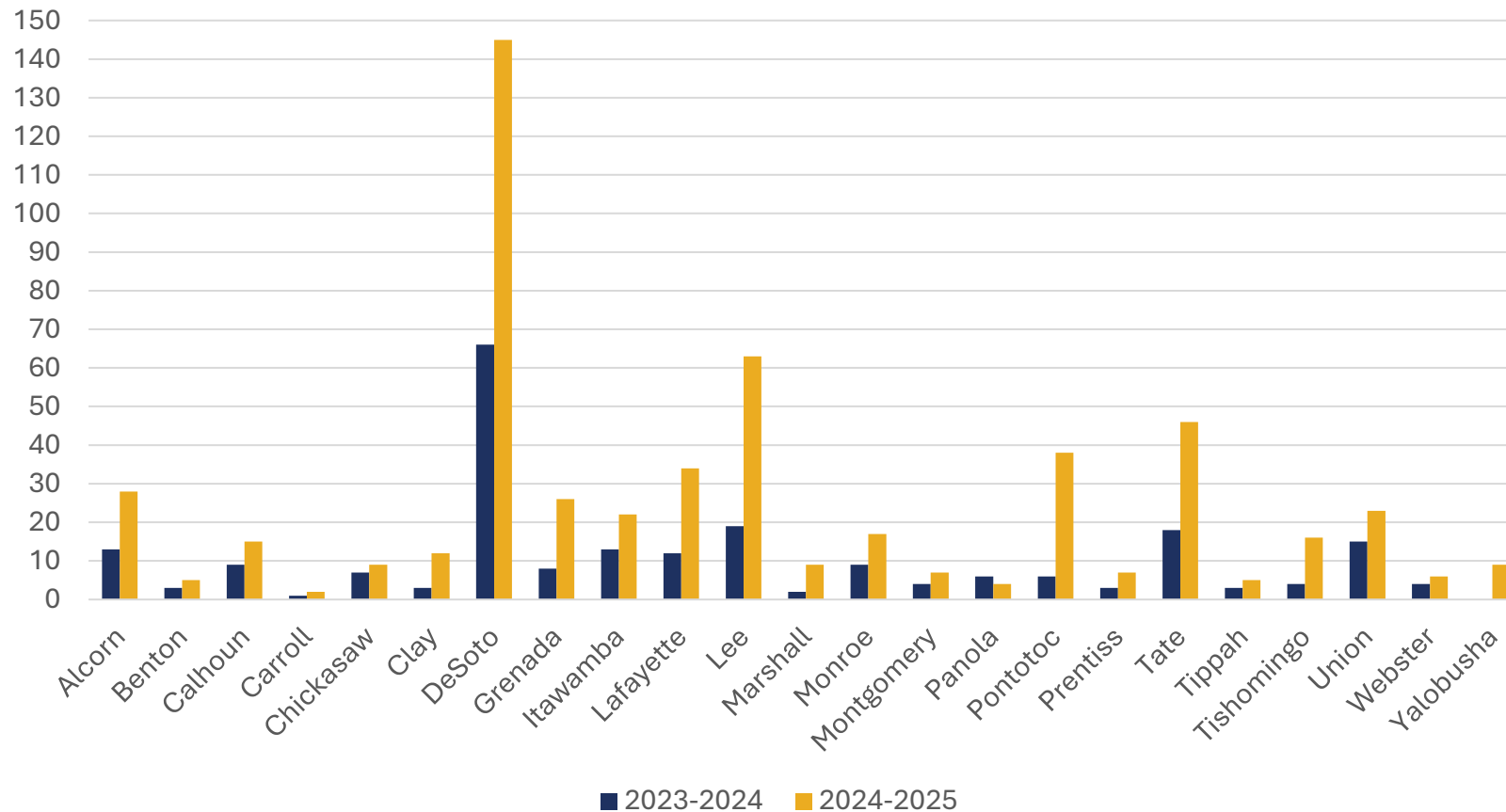
Mississippi 2024-2025 School Religious Exemptions By Year, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten-12th Grade

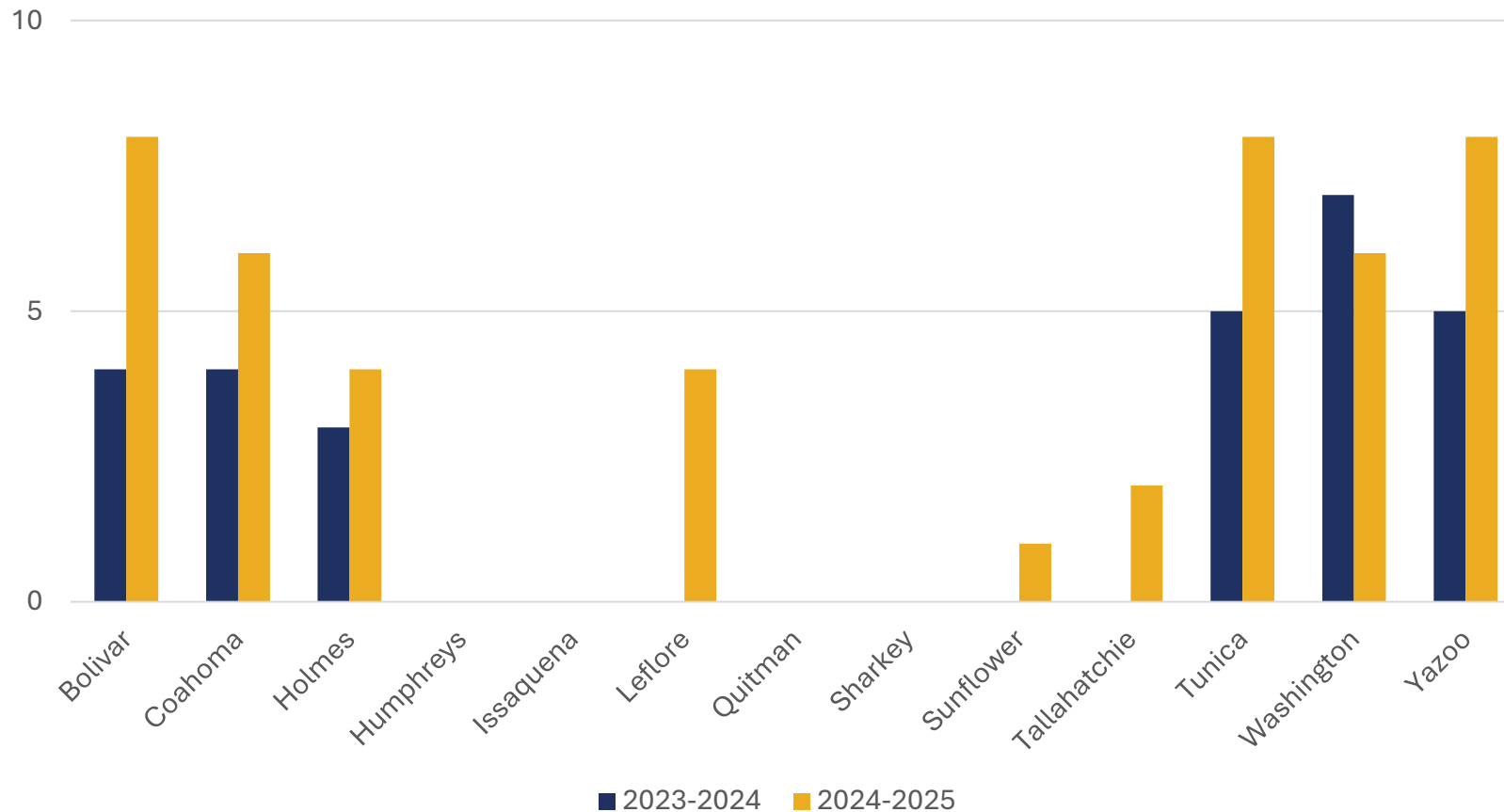
Religious Exemptions Granted by Year & County, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12th Grade

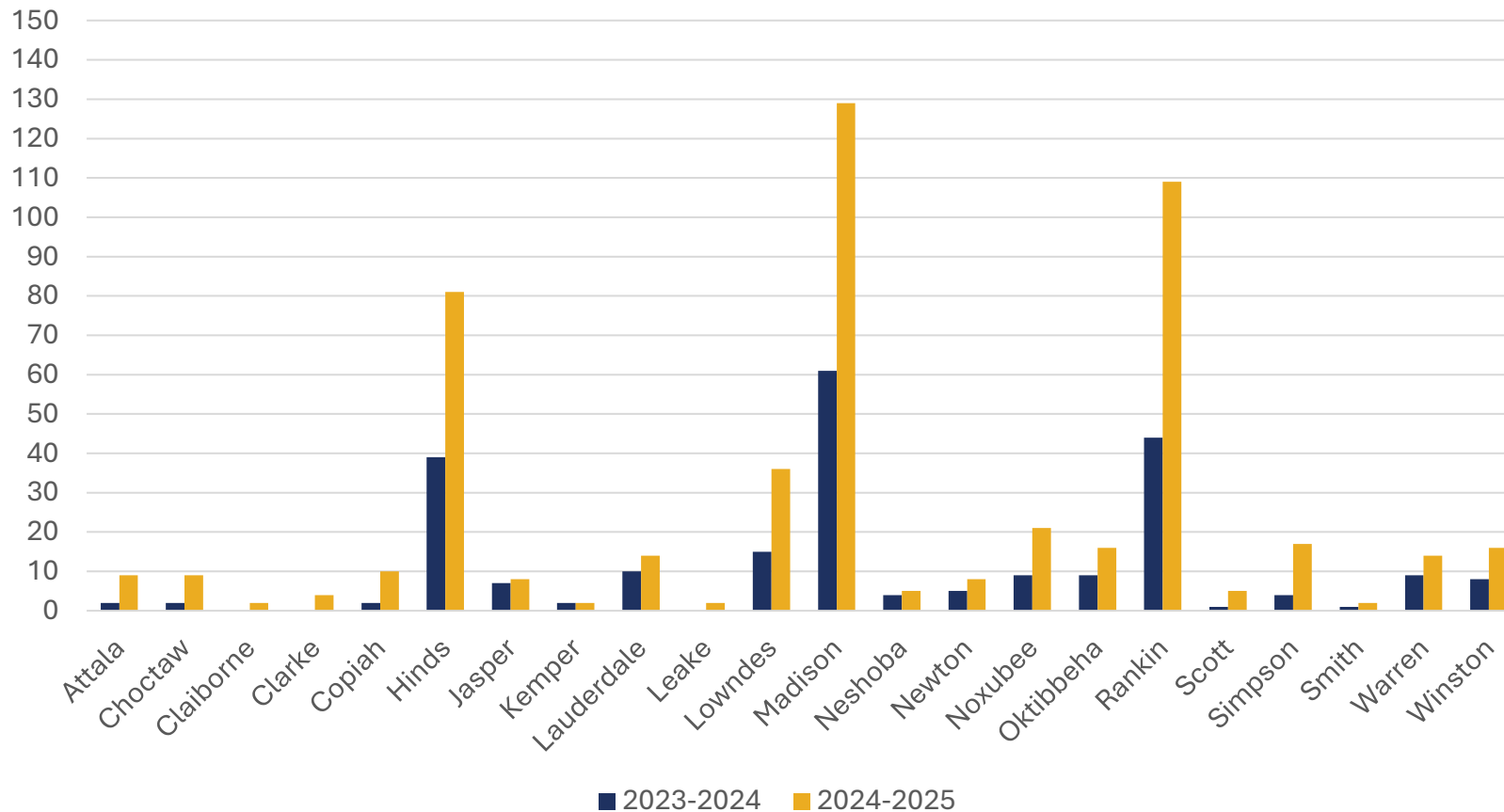
Religious Exemptions Granted by Year & County, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12th Grade

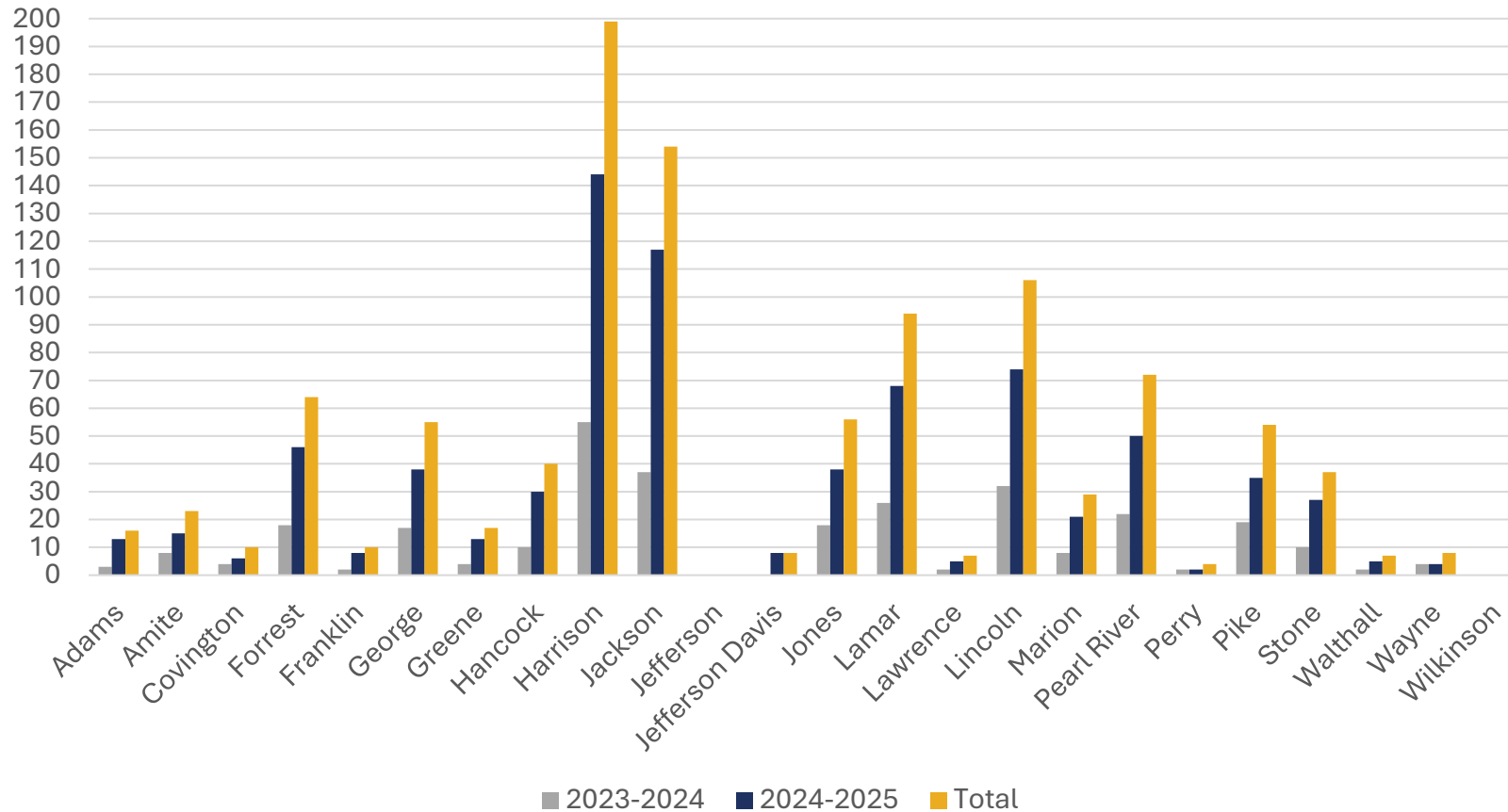
Religious Exemptions Granted by Year & County, Children Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12th Grade

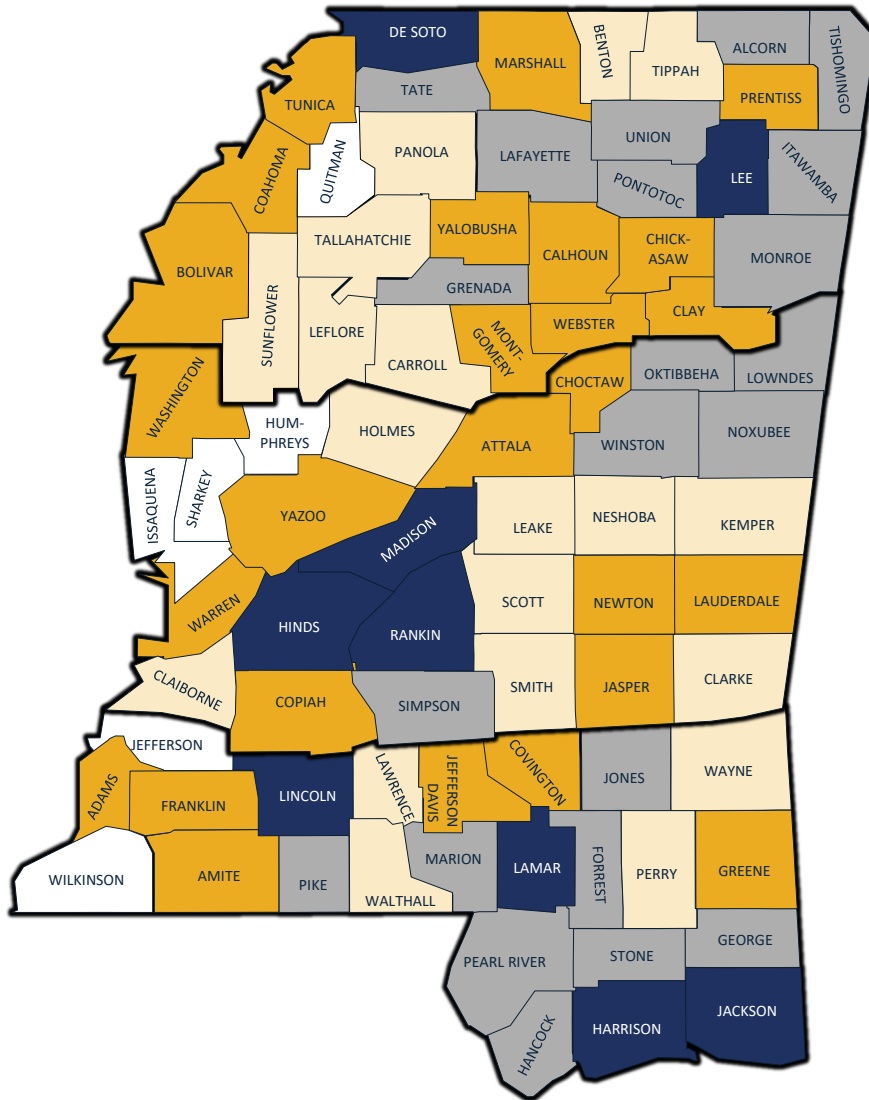
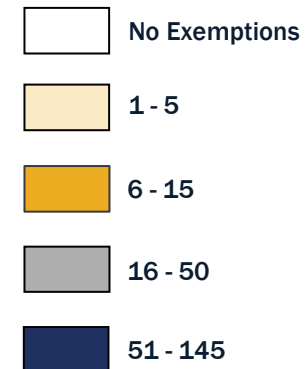
