

About the Position: The Mississippi State Department of Health is seeking to fill a Nurse Team Lead position in Panola County.

Job Responsibilities: This is a Professional Registered Nurse position that will be responsible for providing public health nursing services for county health department clinics within a multi-county public health district as assigned. Duties include conducting patient assessments, developing treatment plans, providing health education, referring patients to care, conducting disease control activities, performing direct patient care procedures and home visitation. Supervise work of county staff nurses, medical aides, License Practical Nurses, medical assistants, serve on emergency/disaster response teams, monitor overall performance and clinic operations of assigned clinics and initiate corrective action as indicated. Prepare reports and documentation for submission to administrative supervisor.

To be Successful: Successful employees need to have excellent multitasking, organizational, and communication skills. Employees must prioritize work to meet deadlines and be an effective team player. Need to have knowledge of MSDH programs and use that knowledge effectively to assist clients and/or patients as needed.
