



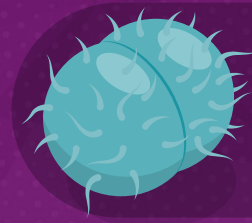

The State of STIs

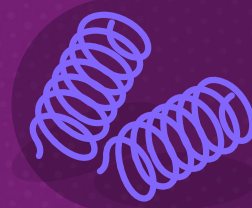
Sexually transmitted
