Job Responsibilities: The Support Care Professional I job responsibilities are to serve the county clinic by performing duties approved for CNA, including checking vital signs, stocking supplies, assisting with medical procedures, cleaning exam rooms, and other duties as assigned. This position requires travel to support various clinics in the Region. Must provide excellent customer service. Employees are required to become familiar with other applicable programs, procedures, and processes of the health department to perform this work.

Employees must prioritize work to meet deadlines and be an effective team player. Ability to develop good rapport with patients and the public.
