

# Mississippi WIC Vendor Reauthorization: Multiple Stores and Accounts

---

## *Frequently Asked Questions*

### **Can I submit more than one reauthorization application using the same OpenGov account?**

No. An OpenGov account can only submit **one** Mississippi WIC Vendor Reauthorization application per account.

### **I own or manage multiple stores. What should I do?**

If all stores operate under the same company/EIN, submit one reauthorization application and include all additional store locations using the Additional Store Attachment.

If stores operate under different companies or different EINs, each company must submit its own reauthorization application. You must have a separate OpenGov account for each company/EIN applying for reauthorization and submit only one application per account.

#### **Example 1**

ABC Grocery, Inc. owns Store #101, Store #102, and Store #103. All stores use the same EIN.

#### **What should I do?**

Submit one application and list the additional stores on the Additional Store Attachment.

#### **Example 2**

John Smith manages ABC Grocery, Inc. (EIN 11-111111) and Smith Foods, LLC (EIN 22-222222). These are separate companies with different EINs.

#### **What should I do?**

Create a separate OpenGov account for each EIN and submit a separate application for each company.

### **Important Reminders**

- One OpenGov account = One reauthorization application.
- One company/corporation/EIN = One reauthorization application.
- Multiple stores under the same company/corporation/EIN may be included on one application.
- You must include the Additional Store Attachment form when applying for multiple locations under the same company/corporation/EIN.
- Separate companies/corporations or separate EINs require separate applications and separate OpenGov accounts.
